

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE

WHEREAS, the 2015-16 Secured Taxes accruing to the County of Santa Barbara and to various School and Community College Districts, and to various Special Districts in the County will not become available until tax collection time on or about December 31, 2015 and April 30, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the cash of such political subdivisions may be insufficient to meet the obligations that will be incurred from July 1, 2015 through April 25, 2016;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara does hereby authorize and direct the County Treasurer of the County of Santa Barbara to make temporary transfers from July 1, 2015 through the last Monday in April, April 25, 2016, from available funds in his custody as County Treasurer, to political subdivisions whose funds are in custody and are paid out solely through the Treasurer's Office, as provided for by Section 6 of Article XVI of the Constitution of the State of California. Said temporary transfers shall be replaced from the revenues accruing to each such political subdivision before any other obligation of said political subdivision is met from such revenue, all as outlined and provided for by Section 6 of Article XVI of the Constitution of the State of California.
