Summary Text:

The Governing Board of the Santa Maria Joint Union High School District (the District) approved the District's Conflict of Interest Code amendments on September 8, 2020. Amendments to the District's Conflict of Interest Code are required to add new positions and to revise the titles of existing positions. Background:

The Political Reform Act of 1974 requires every local government agency to:

- 1. Adopt a conflict of interest code identifying the reporting requirements of covered employees,
- 2. Review the need for any changes to its code biennially, and
- 3. Submit an amended code to "the code reviewing body" if necessitated by changed circumstances. (Gov. Code §§ 87300, 87302, 87306.5, subd. (a).)

The Board of Supervisors is designated as the code reviewing body for independent districts and agencies with jurisdiction wholly within a county. (Gov. Code § 82011, subd. (b).) Once approved by your Board, the District's proposed amended Conflict of Interest Code is deemed adopted. (Gov. Code § 87303.)
