RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING OCTOBER 24th, 2012 FOOD AWARENESS DAY IN SANTA BARBARA COUNTY

WHEREAS, October 24, 2012 is recognized as "Food Awareness Day" which is a time to educate and inform our community about the benefits of eating healthy and nutritious foods; and

WHEREAS, the public is invited to attend a Food Day celebration on October 24 at Community Action Commission (CAC) of Santa Barbara County's Back Door Deli located at Back Door Deli, 315 Camino del Remedio, from 11 am to 1; and

WHEREAS, this local event is part of a nationwide campaign organized by the Center for Science and the Public Interest and will feature representatives from the Santa Barbara Food Policy Council, the Santa Barbara County Public Health Department, CAC's Healthy Senior Lunch and children's nutrition programs, The Food Bank of Santa Barbara County, Farmer Direct Produce and many local food growers; and

WHEREAS, this year's theme, "It's time to eat real Santa Barbara", encourages healthier diets and affordable food grown in a local, sustainable, humane way. Its goals include reducing diet-related disease by promoting healthy foods, supporting sustainable farms, expanding access to food and alleviating hunger in our community, reforming factory farms to protect animals and the environment and curbing junk-food marketing to kids; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors proclaims October 24th, 2012 as "Food Awareness Day" in Santa Barbara County and encourages members of the community participate in planned activities that promote the benefits of healthy eating.
