## LOCAL ENFORCEMENT AGENCY PROCEDURES TO APPOINT A HEARING OFFICER

When, as a result of its acting as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA), Environmental Health Services receives an appeal by an aggrieved individual/party subject to a permit or enforcement action by the LEA or alleging that the LEA failed to act as required by law or regulation, the LEA shall appoint a Hearing Officer to hear the appeal.

The following procedures are to be used when appointing a Hearing Officer:

- 1. The Director of Environmental Health Services will enter into a contract with the California Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) to provide an Administrative Law Judge to act as the hearing officer for the appeal.
- 2. The LEA shall request assignment of an appropriately qualified Administrative Law Judge from the OAH to hear the appeal under the following circumstances:
  - a. Upon receipt of a written request for a hearing by a party subject to an enforcement or permit action by the LEA; or
  - b. Upon receipt of a written request for a hearing by a party alleging that the LEA failed to act as required by law or regulation; or
  - c. Upon receipt of a written request for a hearing by the Santa Barbara County Board of Supervisors prior to the assessment of administrative civil penalties against an owner/operator of a solid waste facility or operation.
