21 The verified fifth and final account and report of JACQUELYN A. QUINN as the
22 successor sole Trustee (hereafter "the Trustee") of the *Giebrich 2007 Trust* dated June 6, 2007,
23 as amended (hereafter "the *Trust*"), together with a Petition for an Order approving the acts of
24 the Trustee and ratifying the payment of the fees and costs of the Trustee and her attorneys,
25 came on regularly for hearing on October 25, 2016, in Department SM 2, the Honorable
26 JAMES F. RIGALI, Judge, presiding.

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1 On proof made to the satisfaction of the Court, the Court finds that all notices of the
2 hearing on the Petition have been given as required by law, that all the facts alleged in the
3 Petition are true, and grants the Petition as follows:

4 **IT IS ORDERED** that:

5 1. The fifth and final account and report of JACQUELYN A. QUINN, the Trustee
6 of the *Giebrich 2007 Trust*, as amended, for the period from November 1, 2015, to and
7 including August 17, 2016, is settled, allowed, and approved as filed.

8 2. All the acts and transactions of the Trustee as set forth in the account and report
9 or relating to the matters set forth in them are ratified, confirmed, and approved.

10 3. The payment of fees to the Trustee in the amount of \$9,836.40 for services
11 rendered during the accounting period, together with reimbursement of costs advanced in the
12 amount of \$99.22, for a total amount paid of \$9,935.62 ($\$9,836.40 + \$99.22 = \$9,935.62$) are
13 ratified, together with reimbursement of costs advanced.

14 4. The payment of fees of MULLEN & HENZELL L.L.P, the attorneys for the
15 Trustee, for payment of services rendered during the accounting period in the amount of
16 \$22,922.25, together with reimbursement of their costs advanced in the amount of \$5,407.10,
17 for a total amount paid of \$28,329.35, is ratified.

18 5. The Trustee is authorized to retain \$20,000 in cash for the closing expenses of
19 Trust administration and to deliver the unused portion to the Charitable Beneficiaries of the
20 Trust estate as set forth in the Petition without further Court Order, after the closing expenses
21 have been paid.

22 6. The following cash and specific gifts shall be made from the Trust estate to the
23 following individuals who survived the Settlor by 30 days as follows:

- 24 A. Cash in the amount of \$5,000 to the ESTATE OF HARRIET M.
25 ELLISON;
- 26 B. Cash in the amount of \$5,000 to EVELYN CHRISTENSEN;
- 27 C. Cash in the amount of \$5,000 to IRMA NEIL;

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- 1 D. Cash in the amount of \$5,000 to ANNA M. UNDERWOOD;
- 2 E. Cash in the amount of \$5,000 and the Settlor's Conant family genealogy
3 book to RONALD D. WHITE;
- 4 F. Cash in the amount of \$25,000 to JACQUELYN A. QUINN, as the
5 Trustee of the *Companion Animal Trust* to be established under *the Giebrich 2007 Trust* dated
6 July 17, 2014;
- 7 G. Cash in the amount of \$100,000, in equal shares, to GERALDINE A.
8 HUMPAL and MERLIN J. HUMPAL;
- 9 H. Cash in the amount of \$50,000, in equal shares, to MARVIN L.
10 BAXENDALE and CAROLYN BAXENDALE;
- 11 I. Antique Chinese chest to CAROLYN BAXENDALE; and
- 12 J. Cash in the amount of \$50,000 to BEULAH M. STAPLETON.
- 13 7. The balance of the Trust estate (less the closing reserve) is to be divided into
14 eight equal shares, and one such equal share shall be distributed to each of the following
15 charitable organizations (the "Charitable Beneficiaries") as follows:
- 16 A. AMERICAN CANCER SOCIETY,
- 17 B. AMERICAN HEART ASSOCIATION,
- 18 C. ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE & RELATED DISORDERS
19 ASSOCIATION OF SANTA BARBARA, INC.,
- 20 D. AMERICAN DIABETES ASSOCIATION,
- 21 E. SANTA BARBARA COUNTY ANIMAL SHELTER (one-half [1/2]
22 to be used in the Santa Barbara Area and the other one-half [1/2] in the Santa Maria area),
- 23 F. SANTA BARBARA COUNTY ANIMAL SHELTER ASSISTANCE
24 PROGRAM FOR CATS (ASAP),
- 25 G. SANTA BARBARA COUNTY HUMANE SOCIETY (one-half [1/2]
26 to be used in the Santa Barbara Area and the other one-half [1/2] in the Santa Maria area); and
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
H. THE SALVATION ARMY and AMERICAN RED CROSS, each to receive a one-half share.

8. Any other property of the Trust estate not now known or discovered that may belong to the Trust estate or in which the decedent or the Trust estate may have any interest shall be distributed to the Charitable Beneficiaries of the Trust estate, as set forth above in paragraph 7.

9. On the filing of receipts from the Trust beneficiaries after the final distribution of the balance in the cash reserve, the Trustee shall be discharged and released from all liability to be incurred thereafter.
