Recommendation(s):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- A. Approve plans and specifications for the Construction of 2001 Storm Damage Repairs on Kinevan Road at Three Locations, County Project No. 01STRM R016;
- B. Award the construction contract in the amount of \$164,778.00 to the lowest responsible bidder, Schock-Hanly Corporation, a California corporation (A Local Vendor), P.O. Box 61505, Santa Barbara, California 93160, subject to the provisions of documents and certification, as set forth in the plans and specifications applicable to the project and as required by law;
- C. Authorize the chair to execute the construction contract upon return of the Contractor's executed contract documents and the review and approval of the County Counsel, Auditor-Controller, and Risk Manager or their authorized representatives; and
- D. Approve a contingency fund in the amount of \$16,477.80 for Construction of 2001 Storm Damage Repairs on Kinevan Road at Three Locations, County Project No. 01STRM R016.

Construction of 2001 Storm Damage Repairs on Kinevan Road at Three Locations, 3rd Supervisorial District,

County Project No. 01STRM R016

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Alignment with Board Strategic Plan:

The recommendations are primarily aligned with Goal No. 1, An Efficient Government Able to Respond Effectively to the Needs of the Community.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

This project consists of repairing storm damage at three locations along Kinevan Road. The project involves repairs to two walls, replacement of a third wall, and construction of rock slope protection on adjacent creek banks. Construction will begin in late September 2003, and will last approximately 2 months. A portion of Kinevan Road will be closed during the construction. There will also be one-way traffic control with flaggers on area streets during part of the construction. Staff is providing information to the community and to emergency services regarding the road closure.

On Thursday, August 21, 2003, four (4) bids were opened for the Construction of 2001 Storm Damage Repairs on Kinevan Road at Three Locations, County Project No. 01STRM R016. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by Schock-Hanly Corporation, a California corporation, in the amount of \$164,778.00, which was 28% above the Engineer's Estimate. There are difficult access issues surrounding Location II, and small volumes of quantities at the other two locations, which resulted in a higher bid than anticipated. Public Works staff has performed an analysis of the bids received and has determined that the low bid is reasonable and recommends awarding this contract to Schock-Hanly Construction.

This project was bid in accordance with the Public Contract Code, which requires the award to the lowest responsible bidder.

The Board approved this project as part of the 2003/2004 Capital Improvement Program.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

The Governor's Office of Emergency Services (OES) Natural Disaster Assistance Act will provide 75% of the total construction cost (\$135,941.85). Measure D will provide the remaining 25% cost (\$45,313.95). Funds have been budgeted in Department 054, Fund 0015, Org Unit 0002, Program 2900, Account 7510 (OES) and Account 7511 (Measure D).
