WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 730 of the statutes of 1976 Section 16429.1 was added to the California Government Code to create a Local Agency Investment Fund in the State Treasury for the deposit of money of a local agency for purposes of investment by the State Treasurer; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara does hereby find that the deposit and withdrawal of money in the Local Agency Investment Fund in accordance with the provisions of Section 16429.1 of the Government Code for the purpose of investment as stated therein is in the best interests of the County; and

WHEREAS, the County Resolution 77-348 currently authorizes specific County officers to deposit and withdraw monies in the Local Agency Fund and the County is desirous of modifying the list of authorized officials;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara as follows:

SECTION 1. The Board of Supervisors does hereby re-authorize the deposit of the County Treasurer's Investment Pool monies not needed for immediate needs and the withdrawal of monies in the Local Agency Investment Fund in the State Treasury in accordance with the provisions of Section 16429.1 of the Government Code for the purpose of investment as stated therein, and verification by the State Treasurer's Office of all banking information provided in that regard.

SECTION 2. The following County of Santa Barbara officers or their successors in office shall be authorized to order the deposit or withdrawal of monies in the Local Agency Investment Fund:

SECTION 3. This Resolution supersedes and replaces Resolution No. 77-348.

SECTION 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
