WITH REFERENCE TO THE FOLLOWING:

- A. Whereas on July 19, 1982, by Ordinance No. 3312, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara adopted the Santa Barbara County Coastal Zoning Ordinance (CZO), Article II of Chapter 35 of the Santa Barbara County Code;
- B. Whereas on February 13, 2024, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara approved an amendment to the County's Local Coastal Program by amending the CZO, Article II of Chapter 35, Zoning, of the County Code, regarding Housing Bill Implementation Project Ordinance Amendments (Ordinance No. 5204, Case No. 21ORD-00003);
- C. Whereas on October 11, 2023, Governor Newsom approved the passage of Senate Bill 423, expanding streamlined housing provisions into the coastal zone effective January 1, 2025 and requiring additional revisions to the Santa Barbara County Coastal Zoning Ordinance (CZO);
- D. Whereas on December 3, 2024, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara approved an amendment to the County's Local Coastal Program by amending the CZO, Article II of Chapter 35, Zoning, of the County Code, regarding the SB 35 Coastal Zone Ordinance Amendment (Ordinance No. 5222, Case No. 24ORD-00010);
- E. Whereas the Board of Supervisors held duly noticed public hearings, as required by Section 65856 of the Government Code, on the amendments referenced above, at which the amendment was explained and comments invited from the persons in attendance;
- F. Whereas this amendment to the Local Coastal Program is consistent with the provisions of the Coastal Act of 1976, the Santa Barbara County Coastal Land Use Plan, and the requirements of State planning and zoning laws as amended to this date; and
- G. The Board of Supervisors now wishes to submit this amendment to the California Coastal Commission for certification.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The above recitations are true and correct.

2. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 65857 of the Government Code and Section 30514 of the Public Resources Code, the above described changes have been adopted as an amendment to the Santa Barbara County Local Coastal Program.
3. The Board of Supervisors certifies that this amendment is intended to be carried out in a manner fully in conformity with the California Coastal Act.
4. The Board directs the Planning and Development Department to submit this Local Coastal Program amendment to the California Coastal Commission for review and certification.
5. The Chair and the Clerk of this Board are hereby authorized and directed to sign and certify all documents and other materials in accordance with this Resolution to reflect the above described action by the Board of Supervisors.

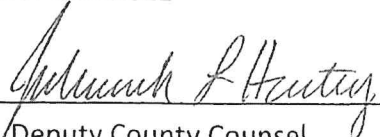
