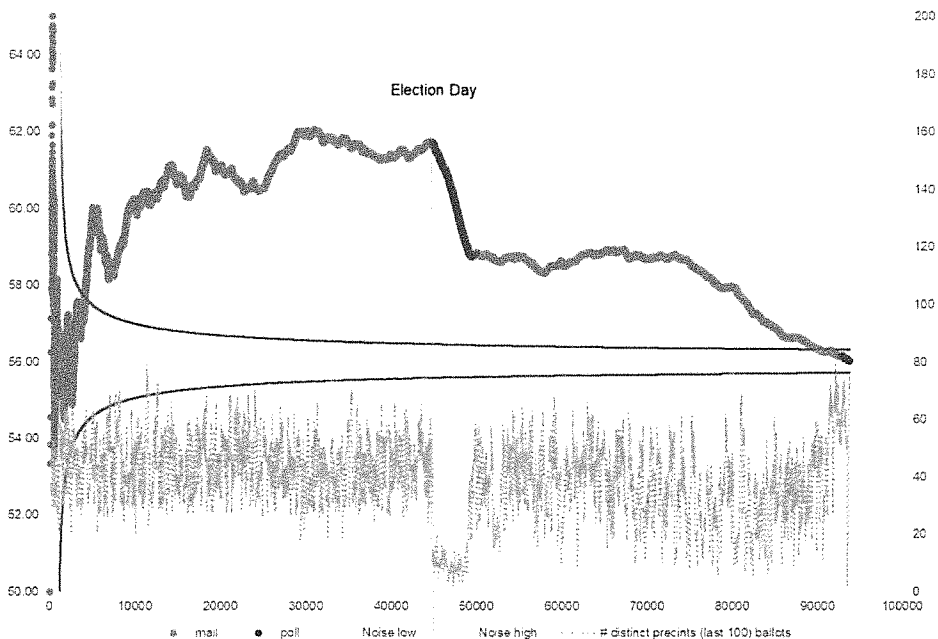

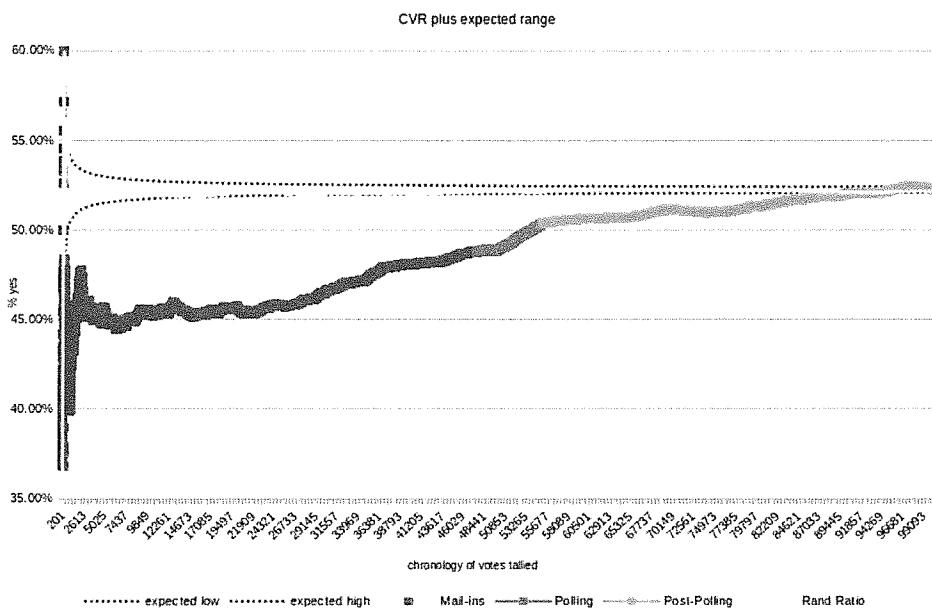

Proposition 1 "No" Votes (Primary 2024)

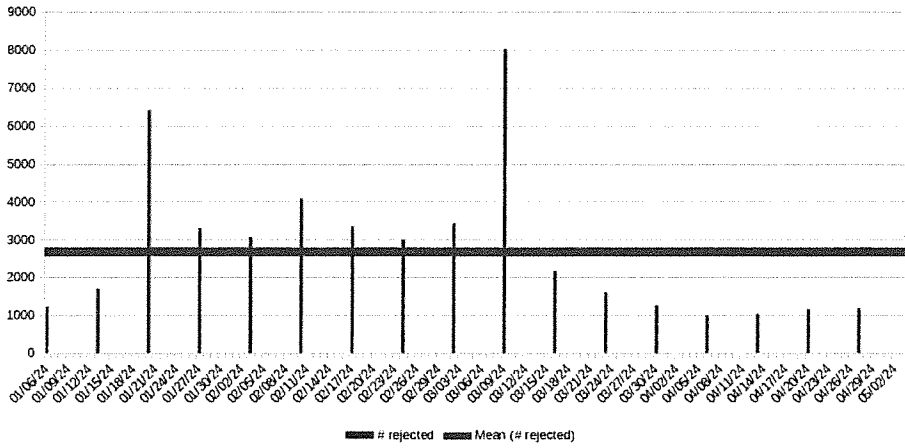

Voter rolls Help America Vote verification-3000 rejections at the state level per week on average. These people don't exist in the social security system.

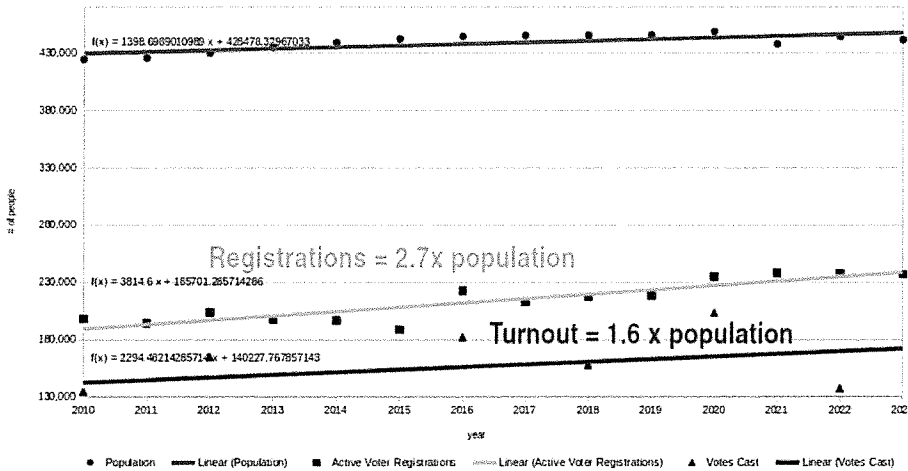
HAVV Rejections For CA

Santa Barbara County Voter rolls are growing at 2.7 times greater than the rate of population growth. This has been tracked since 2010.

In the 2024 Primary election, the reports generated by the computer system for the 1% manual tally show that batches 5 and 28 run through Tabulator 9 each contained 1 overvote. The final Cast Vote Record report details the counting of ballots through all tabulators, and it shows no overvotes for Tabulator 9 batches 5 and 28 -- instead the "YES" totals are one more than the 1% report states. The final Cast Vote Record totals exactly match the certified final report. This must mean that the computer data was changed after the 1% manual tally was performed.

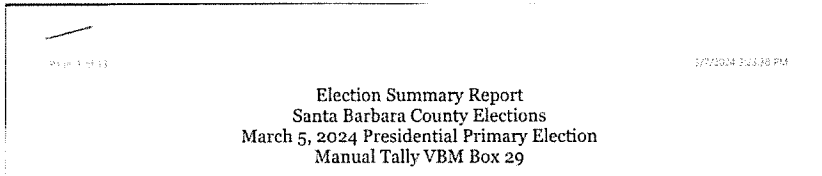

Under Elections Code section 15360(f), counties are required to report to the Secretary of State the results of the 1% manual tally conducted after each election. Elections Code section 15360(e) states:

"The official conducting the election shall include a report on the results of the 1% manual tally in the certification of the official canvass of the vote. This report shall identify any discrepancies between the machine count and the manual tally and a description of how each of these discrepancies was resolved. In resolving any discrepancy involving a vote recorded by means of a punchcard voting system or by electronic or electromechanical vote tabulating devices, the voter verified paper audit trail shall govern if there is a discrepancy between it and the electronic record."
