Second Amendment to the SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT

Between

THE COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA

AND

THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA

This Second Amendment to the Subrecipient Agreement ("AGREEMENT") is entered into by and between the County of Santa Barbara, political subdivision of the State of California ("COUNTY"), and the Housing Authority of the County of Santa Barbara, a public body corporate and politic ("SUBRECIPIENT").

Effective Date: This Amendment shall take effect on the date it is executed by COUNTY ("Effective Date").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, on June 7, 2016, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara executed a subrecipient agreement to provide SUBRECIPIENT with \$493,421 in HOME Investment Partnerships Program ("HOME") funds to administer a Tenant Based Rental Assistance ("TBRA") program. SUBRECIPIENT will provide assistance to low income households with monthly rent, and security and utility deposits in order that they may obtain affordable rental housing; and

WHEREAS, Section 1 of the AGREEMENT, titled "HOME Funds Amount" states that the County agreed to "disburse to SUBRECIPIENT the amount of Four Hundred Ninety Three Thousand Four Hundred Twenty One (\$493,421) in HOME funds;" and

WHEREAS, Section 4.10 of the Scope of Services, Exhibit A to the AGREEMENT, titled "Budget and Fees" states that the SUBRECIPIENT shall expend \$493,421 in HOME funds;" and

WHEREAS, Section 18.9 of the AGREEMENT, titled "Changes or Amendments" includes a provision that "If this Agreement is approved by the County Board of Supervisors and executed by the Chair of the Board of Supervisors on behalf of COUNTY, any amendments to this Agreement must be approved and executed in the same manner..."; and

WHEREAS, on July 19th, 2016 the Santa Barbara County Board of Supervisors approved the First Amendment to the Subrecipient Agreement increasing the amount of HOME TBRA funds by \$650,801.

WHEREAS, COUNTY has sufficient federal HOME funds available to increase the amount of HOME funds in the SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT by \$110,000.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties mutually agree to amend the AGREEMENT as follows:

1. Section 1 of the AGREEMENT is hereby amended as follows:

"In exchange for the satisfactory performance of this Agreement, the COUNTY hereby agrees to disburse to SUBRECIPIENT the amount of One Million, Two Hundred and Fifty Four Thousand, Two Hundred and Twenty Two (\$1,254,222) One Million One Hundred Forty Four Thousand Two Hundred Twenty Two (\$1,144,222) Four Hundred Ninety Three Thousand Four Hundred Twenty One (\$493,421) in HOME funds:" and

2. Section 4.10 of EXHIBIT A Scope of Services is hereby amended as follows:
