TED SCOTT FOR HIS CONTRIBUTIONS
TO THE COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA

WHEREAS, Ted Scott is a Missouri native and has been an active Elk since 1953; and

WHEREAS, in 1984, Ted retired from Gulf Oil and has spent nearly all his retirement years as a community volunteer to Santa Maria, California; and

WHEREAS, Ted has been an organizer of the Marian Medical Center Dialysis Golf Tournament; and

WHEREAS, Ted and his late wife, Louise, made thirty trips that were 1,550 miles each to a distant Arizona Navajo reservation to deliver donated food and clothing; and

WHEREAS, Ted has faithfully served Elks Lodge No. 1538 in chairmanships, as Lodge and Rodeo Historian, as Recreation Secretary and as Publication Editor; and

WHEREAS, in 1991 Ted was named Citizen of the Year by the Elks Lodge; in 1994 he received the Santa Maria Valley Chamber of Commerce Mayor's Tourism Award; and in 1997 he was the Grand Marshal of the Santa Maria Elks Rodeo and Parade; and

WHEREAS, Ted has been instrumental in the continuing success of the Elks' Rodeo and helped the Elks acquire the 107 acres where the rodeo grounds are located; and

WHEREAS, Ted has worked tirelessly to complete the new BMX Track serving all of the area's youthful biking enthusiasts.
