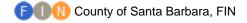

Justification: This budget revision recognizes \$300,000 in grant revenue from the State of California Natural Resources Agency (CNRA) as part of an agreement entered

into by the County to become the fee owner of the Foothills Forever project property which will be preserved as public open space in perpetuity. The CNRA was delegated responsibility for allocating \$3 million in State grant funds for the Foothills Forever project. A provision contained in the grant stated that 90% (\$2.7 million) of the \$3 million was to be disbursed into escrow towards the Foothills Forever project and that 10% (\$300 thousand) be withheld and subsequently provided to the County once the County becomes the fee owner. Per the agreement, all remaining and residual monies shall be remitted to the

Santa Barbara Foundation as the fiscal agent, to complete the transaction. This budget revision establishes \$300,000 of appropriations in services and
