PROJECT TITLE: Contract amendment with CalPortland Construction, Inc. for the Construction of Highway Safety Improvement on Betteravia Road in the Third Supervisorial District.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Request for the Board of Supervisors to authorize the Chair of the Board to approve and execute a construction contract amendment for the Construction of Highway Safety Improvement on Betteravia Road in the Third Supervisorial District. The scope of the contract amendment will increase the payment amount by \$71,980.00 for a contract amount of \$633,956.00 for services with CalPortland Construction. This contract amendment will allow the contractor to increase the surface area of pavement treatment to include the full-width of the existing shoulders in advance of edge line rumble strip installation. Treating the entire shoulder width will minimize future maintenance costs and improve safety by creating a wider, uniform shoulder for bicycles and vehicles that may veer out of the travel way.



The term project does not mean each separate governmental approval. Further, the execution of the contract will not create any unusual circumstances which would create a possibility that there would be a significant effect.
