While state and federal disaster relief played a critical role in community recovery, undocumented residents—estimated to comprise approximately 10% of the population in Ventura and Santa Barbara Counties—were categorically excluded from millions of dollars in available assistance. The organization fills a critical gap by delivering emergency assistance, stabilization resources, and trusted community support. The requested funds will be used to continue providing services for short-term, in-kind, non-cash emergency disaster relief for undocumented communities in Santa Barbara County.
