

Environmental Health Services Body Art Fee Resolution

Background

AB 186

- Passed Oct 1997; effective January 1998
- Required Body Art Practitioners to:
 - Register with local Health Dept
 - Pay a one-time registration fee
 - Pay an annual inspection fee
 - Agree to meet Health Dept standards
- Required CA Conference of Local Health Officers to develop sanitation and safety standards

AB 300

AB 300 – Safe Body Art Act

- Signed into law Oct 2011; effective January 1, 2012
- Repealed the provisions of AB 186
- Amended Health & Safety Code to include standards for Body Art facilities and practitioners

Requirements

Practitioners are now required to:

- Register with the local enforcement agency
- Renew their registration annually
- Meet specified operating standards and procedures

Requirements

- Requires owner/operators of Body Art facilities to:
 - Obtain a health permit
 - Pay an annual permit fee
 - Meet specified construction standards
 - If proposing a new facility, submit plans for review
- Establishes standards for vehicles and temporary events

Proposed Fee Resolution

- The proposed new fees and fee structure reflect current law
 - Annual Facility Health Permit Fee (new)
 - Annual Vehicle Health Permit (new)
 - Annual Practitioner Registration Fee (new)
 - Temporary Event Organizer Fee
 - Temporary Event Practitioner Fee
 - Plan Review Fee (new)
