PROJECT TITLE Santa Rosa Road Bridge (51C-173) Seismic Replacement

PROJECT DESCRIPTION. The existing bridge 51C-173 will be removed and replaced with a roadway embankment designed to meet current roadway design standards. Proposed project is to remove the existing bridge 51C-173, located on Santa Rosa Road and the Avenue of the Flags near Buellton, CA as it is not financially feasible to conduct a seismic retrofit upgrade to the existing structure when removal is an option. Bridge 51C-173 was constructed in 1949 and is a simple span steel structure 400' in length with a total width of 31'. The project will require approximately 14,000 cubic yards of fill and 2000 cubic yards of cut to create the new roadway embankment. Construction activities will impact an area of approximately 102,000 square feet of total disturbance. A temporary detour road will be required during construction. The temporary detour road will run for a length of approximately .2 miles immediately adjacent to the construction site between Santa Rosa Road and Highway 101

Cite specific CEQA Guideline Section 15301 (c) Existing Facilities - "...consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond that previously existing, including but not limited to:...(c) Existing highways and streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and similar facilities (this includes road grading for the purpose of public safety), except where the activity will involve removal of a scenic resource including a stand of trees, a rock outcropping, or an historic building.

Reasons to support exemption findings: The project is seismic repair of an existing County maintained bridge and therefore is contemplated by the CEQA exemption under section 15301. The project has been determined to be exempt from Santa Barbara County P&D permit requirements and a NEPA Categorical Exclusion has been issued under Section 6004 based on existing land uses and where the actions were originally evaluated in accordance with applicable laws, regulation and surrounding circumstances have not changed.
