WHEREAS, Cheryl Smith maintained security on the County's mainframe for almost 30 years including the implementation of a modernized tape backup system, the management of over 10,000 backup tapes for disaster recovery, and the retirement of the backup system upon completion of PC emulated mainframe environment;

WHEREAS, Cheryl Smith has a reputation for problem solving, exceptional customer service and tireless dedication to her colleagues, the County, and the public at all hours of the day or night;

WHEREAS, Cheryl Smith is noted for her amazing baking skills and her willingness to share a favorite recipe;
