## Oversized Vehicle Parking Restriction



Amend County Code Section 23-13.12 to include the Burton Mesa Boulevard in Vandenberg Village for the purpose of prohibiting overnight parking of oversized vehicles.



### Oversized Vehicle




Meets or exceeds at least one criteria (exclusive of fixtures):



Or 8 feet in width

## Oversized Vehicle Parking Restriction





#### Recommendations



#### That the Board of Supervisors:

- Approve the introduction (first reading) of an Ordinance amending Santa Barbara County Code Chapter 23, Section 23-13.12 to prohibit the parking of oversized vehicles between the hours of 10:00 pm and 6:00 am on Burton Mesa Boulevard in the community of Vandenberg Village; Third Supervisorial District; and to authorize the removal of oversized vehicles parked in violation of Santa Barbara County Code Chapter 23, Section 23-13.12; All Supervisorial Districts;
- On February 16, 2016, on the Administrative Agenda;
- Consider and approve the adoption (second reading) of an Ordinance amending Santa Barbara County Code Chapter 23, Section 23-13.12 to prohibit the parking of oversized vehicles between the hours of 10:00 pm and 6:00 am in the community of Vandenberg Village; Third Supervisorial District; and to authorize the removal of oversized vehicles parked in violation of Santa Barbara County Code Chapter 23, Section 23-12.12; All Supervisorial Districts;
- Read the title of the Ordinance and waive the reading of the Ordinance in full;
- Find that the proposed action is for the operation and maintenance of existing public facilities, involving negligible, or no expansion of use beyond that which presently exists, that the proposed action is therefore exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to 14 CCR 15301; and
- Approve and direct staff to file the attached Notice of Exemption.
