

I was one of the organizers of the Peace movement here in Santa Barbara against the illegal wars started following 9/11 in 2003-2007, lobbying then Congressman Lois Capps for her vote, citing the literally thousands marching down State Street as her constituency's voice for peace. Recipient along with my husband Gregory Freeland of a Lifetime Achievement Award from Central Coast Alliance United for a Sustainable Economy (CAUSE) in April 2017. Recipient of 2013 Excellence in Public Service Award by the Asian/Pacific Islander Legislative Caucus of the State Legislature. Received Woman of the Year award for the State Senate District 19 in March 2017.
