The County Planning Commission now finds that it is in the interest of the orderly development of the County and important to the preservation of the health, safety and general welfare of the residents of the County to recommend that the Board of Supervisors adopt an ordinance (Case No. 110RD-00000-00012) amending Section 35-1 of Chapter 35 of the Santa Barbara County Code, the Santa Barbara County Land Use and Development Code, to implement new regulations and make other minor clarifications, corrections and revisions.
 - Said Ordinance is attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and is incorporated herein by reference.
- C. The proposed Ordinance is consistent with the Coastal Act of 1976, the Santa Barbara County Coastal Plan, the Santa Barbara County Comprehensive Plan including the Community Plans, and the requirements of the State Planning, Zoning and Development Laws.

The proposed Ordinance is in the interest of the general community welfare since it will serve to clarify, update, and streamline the development permit process without compromising community values, environmental quality, or the public health and safety. The proposed ordinance amendments will (1) revise existing permit processes to enhance clarity and efficiency, (2) add new development standards and restrictions pertaining to specific land uses that will serve to minimize potential adverse impacts to the surrounding area, and (3) correct and clarify existing text provisions.
- E. This County Planning Commission has held a duly noticed public hearing, as required by Section 65854 of the Government Code, on the proposed Ordinance at which hearing the proposed Ordinance was explained and comments invited from the persons in attendance.
