That the Board of Supervisors:

Authorize the transfer of County Vehicle # 3319, an Armored Personnel Carrier, to the Lompoc Police Department.

Summary Text:

The Sheriff's Department has had in its vehicle fleet an Armored Personnel Carrier (APC) for several years. This operating cost vehicle has been used as a Special Enforcement Team (SET) asset, transporting personnel in high risk activities. With the acquisition of the B.E.A.R. (Ballistic Engineered Armored Response) vehicle in 2007, the APC was no longer needed. The Sheriff's Department wishes to transfer the APC to Lompoc Police Department, who will maintain and use the vehicle for their SET operations.

Background:

Vehicle #3319, a 1978 Cadillac V150 Armored 4 X 4, was acquired by the Sheriff's Department in 1995 as a transfer from the federal government as surplus property. Transfer of the APC to Lompoc Police Department will be a consistent use as the vehicle will continue to be used by front-line law enforcement.
