


A Clear and Present Need for Affordable Housing

- Local real estate prices and rentals have skyrocketed by 30%+ in the last few years, while wages remain the same
- The City of Santa Barbara is the most expensive small city in America for single-family home rents
- Santa Barbara County is the 6th most expensive county in America
- Santa Barbara County has the 2nd highest rate of poverty in California
- 42% of households in the County of Santa Barbara fall below the real cost measure of what it actually takes to live here



The South Coast is set to surpass its above moderate/market rate housing target early in the 6th cycle, based on pending/proposed units^{**}





Disproportionate Geographic Impacts



Roughly 75% of new housing in the South Coast is proposed to be built in the Eastern Goleta Valley, **a 3.5** mile radius.
