That the Board of Supervisors:

- A. Approve and Authorize the Chair to execute a Resolution to rescind Resolution 95-207, which established a multiway (4-way) stop control on California Boulevard at Clubhouse Drive in the Orcutt area; Fourth Supervisorial District; and
- B. Approve the filing of a Notice of Exemption pursuant to California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Section 15301 (c), pertaining to maintenance and operation of existing facilities, for this project.

Summary Text:

The intersection of California Boulevard and Clubhouse Drive is currently controlled by a 4-way stop. The City of Santa Maria has recently completed its portion of Union Valley Parkway, which crosses California Boulevard at a location approximately 200 feet north of Clubhouse Drive. New stop signs have been installed on California Boulevard at Union Valley Parkway. As a result, vehicles traveling on California Boulevard must stop at two intersections that are very close together. The County Public Works Department conducted an Engineering Study at the intersection of California Boulevard at Clubhouse Drive. Based on our investigation the Department recommends removal of the stop signs on California Boulevard at Clubhouse Drive. The Department has prepared the attached resolution to rescind the multiway (4-way) stop control at the following location:

Background:

Stop controls are established based on traffic volumes and safety measures. These factors are weighed by the Public Works Department and any changes recommended are presented to the Board of Supervisors for approval.

Resolution No. 95-207 establishing a multiway (4-way) stop control at the intersection of California Boulevard and Clubhouse Drive was approved by the Board of Supervisors on May 9, 1995.
