

**RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING MAY 2004)
AS WATER AWARENESS MONTH)
IN THE COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA)**

WHEREAS, water is California's most precious resource and our quality of life and economic well-being depend on the efficient and prudent management of water resources; and

WHEREAS, the County of Santa Barbara, through the Public Works Department, is working cooperatively to conserve and protect our valuable water resources with water purveyors throughout the county; and

WHEREAS, this cooperative effort was established because the efficient use of our local water resources is a priority; and

WHEREAS, during May 2004, organizations in Santa Barbara County and throughout California will organize activities to educate the public about water management efforts of business, agriculture, industry, and others;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND HEREBY ORDERED that the County of Santa Barbara Board of Supervisors, State of California, proclaims May 2004 as California Water Awareness Month, and urges all residents learn more about their water resources and the importance of wise water use and to join in supporting local water agencies and organizations in their effort to help Californians "Use water wisely and keep it clean – It's a way of life."
