Box 50085 Watsonville, CA 95077, subject to the provisions of documents and certification, as set forth in the plans and specifications applicable to the project and as required by law;
- C. Authorize the chair to execute the construction contract upon return of the Contractor's executed contract documents and the review and approval of the County Counsel, Auditor-Controller, and Risk Manager or their authorized representatives; and
- Approve a contingency fund in the amount of \$37,436.65 for Construction of Gibraltar Road Retaining Walls at M.P. 0.8, 0.9, and 1.1, First Supervisorial District, County Project Number 05STRM.

### **Summary:**

On Thursday, May 25th, 2005, two (2) bids were opened for the Construction of Gibraltar Road Retaining Walls at M.P. 0.8, 0.9, and 1.1, First Supervisorial District, County Project Number 05STRM. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by Granite Construction Company, a California corporation (Not a Local Vendor), in the amount of \$498,733.00, which is 4% over the Engineer's Estimate. Due to the specialized nature of the construction techniques required, a select number of contactors bid on this project. Public Works staff has performed an analysis of the bids received and has determined that the low bid is reasonable and recommends awarding this contract to Granite Construction Company.

This project was bid in accordance with the Public Contract Code, which requires the award to the lowest responsible bidder.

Construction will begin in late July 2006, and will last approximately 3 months. During normal working hours traffic will be controlled by flaggers with an anticipated maximum delay of 10 minutes. Work requiring full closure of Gibraltar Road will only occur from 9PM to 6AM. Local residents are aware of the traffic control requirements for this project.

#### **Background:**

During the initial series of storms of January 2005, intense rainfall runoff caused severe erosion and downhill slope failures at several locations on Gibraltar Road resulting in loss of slope material as well as unpaved shoulder and paved roadway posing a hazard to the health and safety of the traveling public. Three of the storm damage locations will be repaired during this project.

This project and the CEQA Notice of Exemption were approved by your Board on 4/26/05.

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#### Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

The total project funding, including contingencies, amounts to \$536,169.65. Of this total, \$402,127.24(75%) is provided by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), and \$134,042.41(25%) is provided by the State Office of Emergency Services (OES).
