COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA RESOLUTION HONORING CAROLE DOANE AS THE 2007 SANTA BARBARA FOUNDATION WOMAN OF THE YEAR CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, Carole Doane has been selected as the 2007 Woman of the Year by the Santa Barbara Foundation in recognition of the contribution she has made to the quality of life in the community; and

WHEREAS, Carole Doane has devoted her time and energies to countless local organizations and causes, focusing her efforts, with creativity and enthusiasm, on overcoming seemingly insurmountable challenges and serving a a hands-on volunteer; and

WHEREAS, during her tenure with the Junior League of Santa Barbara Carole Doane chaired Dr. Charlotte Elmott's Child Guidance Study for City Schools, and served as Vice-President of the Board and Chair of the Ways and Means Committee; and

WHEREAS, Carole began her volunteer service with Girls, Inc. by teaching young girls to dance and she has since accepted leadership positions within the organization that include chairing several committees and developing the Opening Doors Capital Campaign; and

WHEREAS, Carole Doane has made significant contributions to the Santa Barbara Mental Health Association helping to establish a therapeutic program for young adults involved in soft crime which resulted in the creation of Phoenix House, a residential recovery center for those experiencing mental illness; and

WHEREAS, Carole has further demonstrated her commitment to volunteerism by founding the Santa Barbara County General Hospital League, tutoring young residents at Noah's Anchorage, delivering donated food to the Community Kitchen, assisting Community Kitchen clients with transportation to the Victoria Hotel Self-Help Project, and serving as an observer at Juvenile Justice Commission Hearings;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisor honors Carole Doane as the recipient of the 2007 Santa Barbara Foundation Woman of the Year Award and further commends her for a lifetime of outstanding leadership and dedicated service to her community.
