FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT FOR SERVICES

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT (hereafter, First Amendment) to the Subrecipient Agreement for American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Child Care Sector Relief and Recovery Initiative services by and between the County of Santa Barbara (County), a political subdivision of the State of California, and United Way of Santa Barbara County, Inc. (Subrecipient), a California non-profit corporation with an address at 321 E. Gutierrez Street, Santa Barbara, CA 93101 (UEI Number VVL1S3LJJ9RL6), for the continued provision of services specified herein.

WHEREAS, County and Subrecipient (collectively, the parties) entered into a Subrecipient Agreement for Services, BC No. BC23068 for the provision of ARPA Child Care Sector Relief and Recovery Initiative services supporting the child care sector impacted by the Covid-19 pandemic for a total contract maximum amount not to exceed \$1,000,000 for the period of March 15, 2023, through June 30, 2025, (Agreement); and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to extend the term of the contract from June 30. 2025, to December 31, 2025, with no change to the maximum contract amount.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and conditions contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. Delete Section 4 (Term) of the Standard Terms and Conditions of the Agreement and replace it with the following:

4. <u>TERM.</u>

SUBRECIPIENT shall commence performance on March 15, 2023, and end performance upon completion, but no later than December 31, 2025 unless otherwise directed by COUNTY or unless earlier terminated.

- 2. All other terms shall remain in full force and effect.
- **3.** Execution of Counterparts. This First Amendment may be executed in any number of counterparts, and each of such counterparts shall for all purposes be deemed to be an original, and all such counterparts, or as many of them as the parties shall preserve undestroyed, shall together constitute one and the same instrument.
