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Executive Summary and Discussion:

This project is included in the Fire Year Capital Improvement Plan dated July 1, 2001 – June 30, 2006 under the category "Support Services, General Services." The addition will be constructed adjacent to the existing vehicle operations building. The new addition will provide 3,386 SF of truck maintenance office space to be leased to the Air Pollution Control District, Santa Barbara County Association of Governments, and County Social Services Department. Construction is expected to be completed by March 2003.
