Consultants List

Recommendation:

That the Board of Supervisors set a hearing for May 23, 2006 to receive a report on the maintenance of the Specialty Consultants List for the Planning and Development Department.

The new procedures will include guidelines for qualifying a consultant for placement on the list, removal of consultants from the list, requiring regular updates from consultants on their qualifications, and contract management procedures for staff and applicants using these consultants.
