During a major emergency or disaster it is important that all areas of local government respond in a coordinated manner. This workshop with the Board will discuss the important role of elected governing boards and their staff during emergencies. The workshop will also discuss the management/policy role of the EOC, and how it relates to the department operating centers and the incident commander.

Consideration and discussion will address pre-event actions, the role of the County Executive Officer (who serves as the Emergency Services Director for the Operational Area) and the challenges that routinely occur to pre-event plans.
