WHEREAS, by resolution No. 02-212, this Board established certain fees, charges and penalties for Animal Services, and

WHEREAS, circumstances have changed since June 4, 2002, when said resolution was adopted, and it is now necessary to change some of said fees, charges and penalties to reflect the increasing cost of providing Animal Control Services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the following be the schedule of fees, charges and penalties for Animal Services by the County of Santa Barbara, effective March 1, 2006, in place and instead of those fees set forth in Resolution No. 02-212.

A. Impound Fees

Veterinarians, and other agencies who participate in the County Licensing program will be reimbursed two dollars (\$2.00) for each license sold at local offices.

The fees for Licenses sold include the following amounts to be deposited into the Animal Services Capital Improvement Trust Fund: \$1 for one-year Altered and New Adoptions; \$2 for 2-year Altered and 1-year Unaltered; \$3 for 3-year Altered; \$4 for 2-year Unaltered; and \$6 for 3-year Unaltered.

The Director of Animal Services shall have the authority to waive fees and/or establish payment schedules. (When approved, the usual payment schedule will be 60 percent at time of service and two additional monthly payments of 20 percent.)

Waiving of fees is under the discretion of the Animal Services Director.
