WHEREAS, the mission of Santa Barbara School Districts is to ensure the educational success of all students through high expectations and a commitment to excellence and to empower them to reach their full potential as responsible, ethical, and productive citizens in a diverse and changing world; and

WHEREAS, Santa Barbara School Districts adheres to a set of core beliefs and principles that set a standard of excellence in education including: achieving the Districts' mission is a shared responsibility requiring the cooperation and commitment of students, parents, staff, board members, and the community; that academic excellence is ensured by providing quality educational programs with all staff members focused on continually improving student achievement; promoting a culture of mutual trust and respect among students, parents, staff, and community members; and valuing student and staff diversity in schools and classrooms to ensure equal access across all educational programs and activities; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors honors Santa Barbara School Districts upon its 145<sup>th</sup> anniversary and further commends the Districts staff and Board for its commitment to educating the next generation of community leaders.
