WHEREAS, community service helps to bolster civic engagement, improve neighborhoods and promote economic and social well-being; and

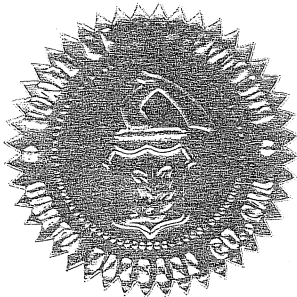
