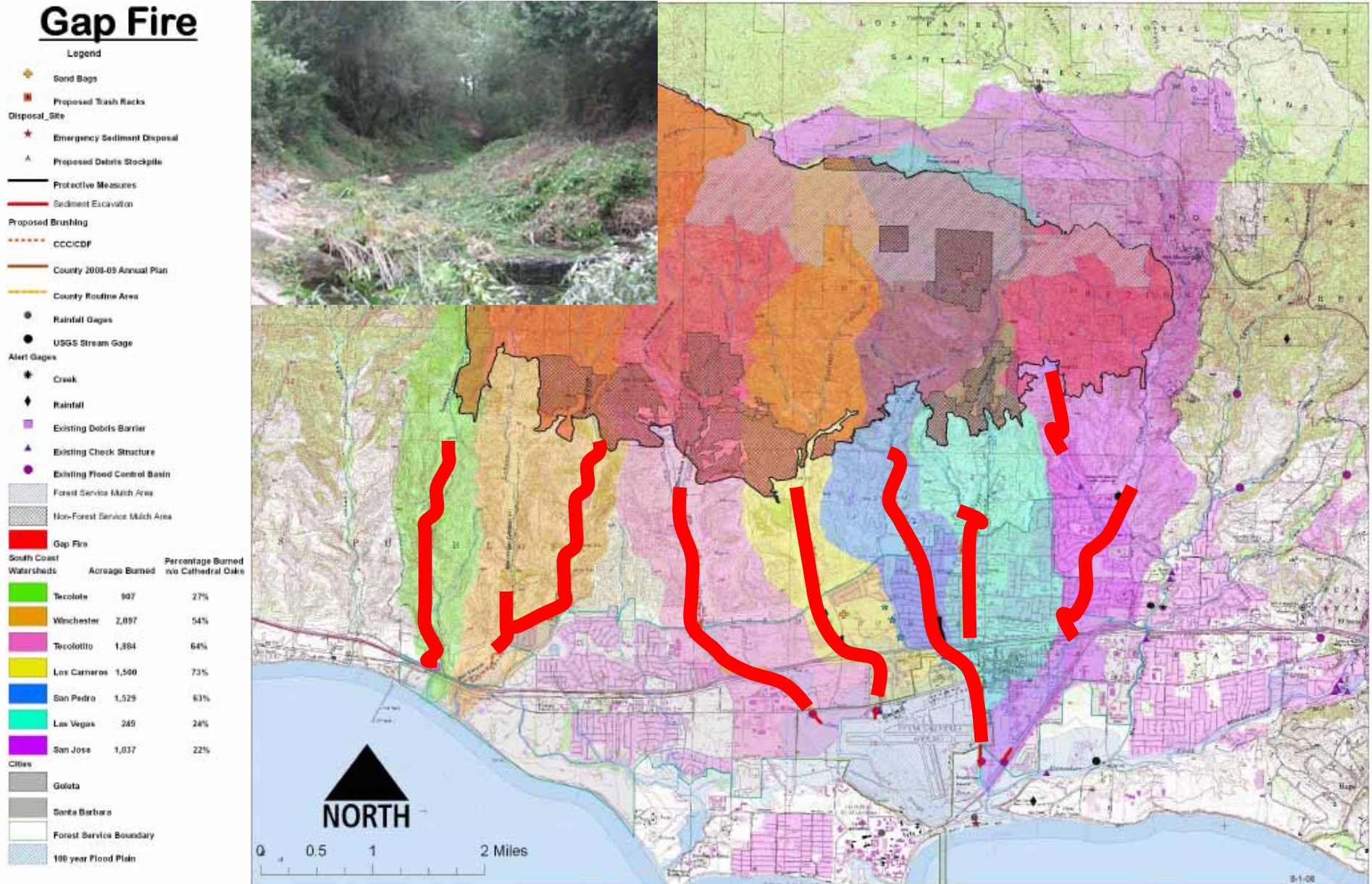

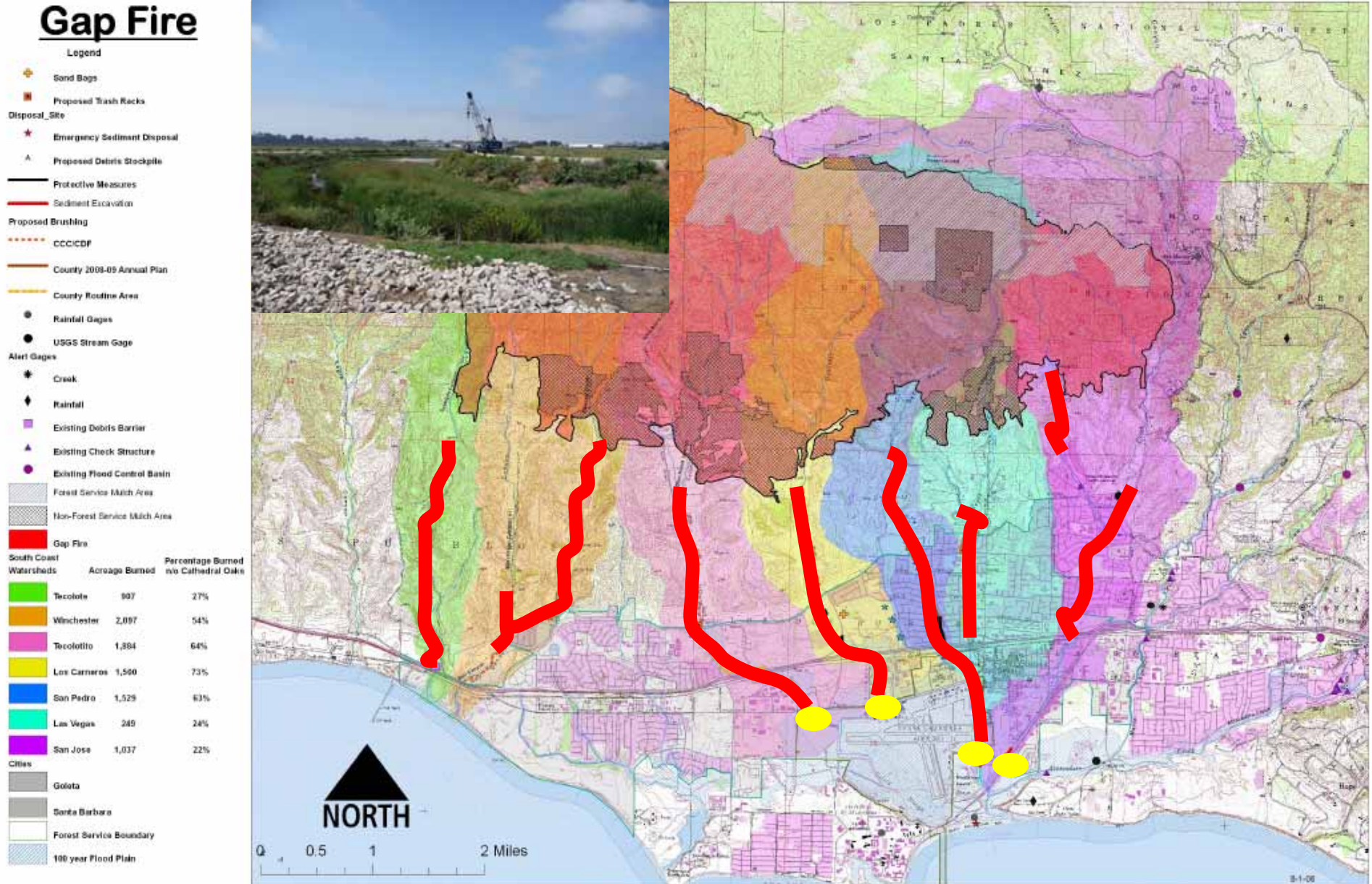
Stream Clearing – Work Identified



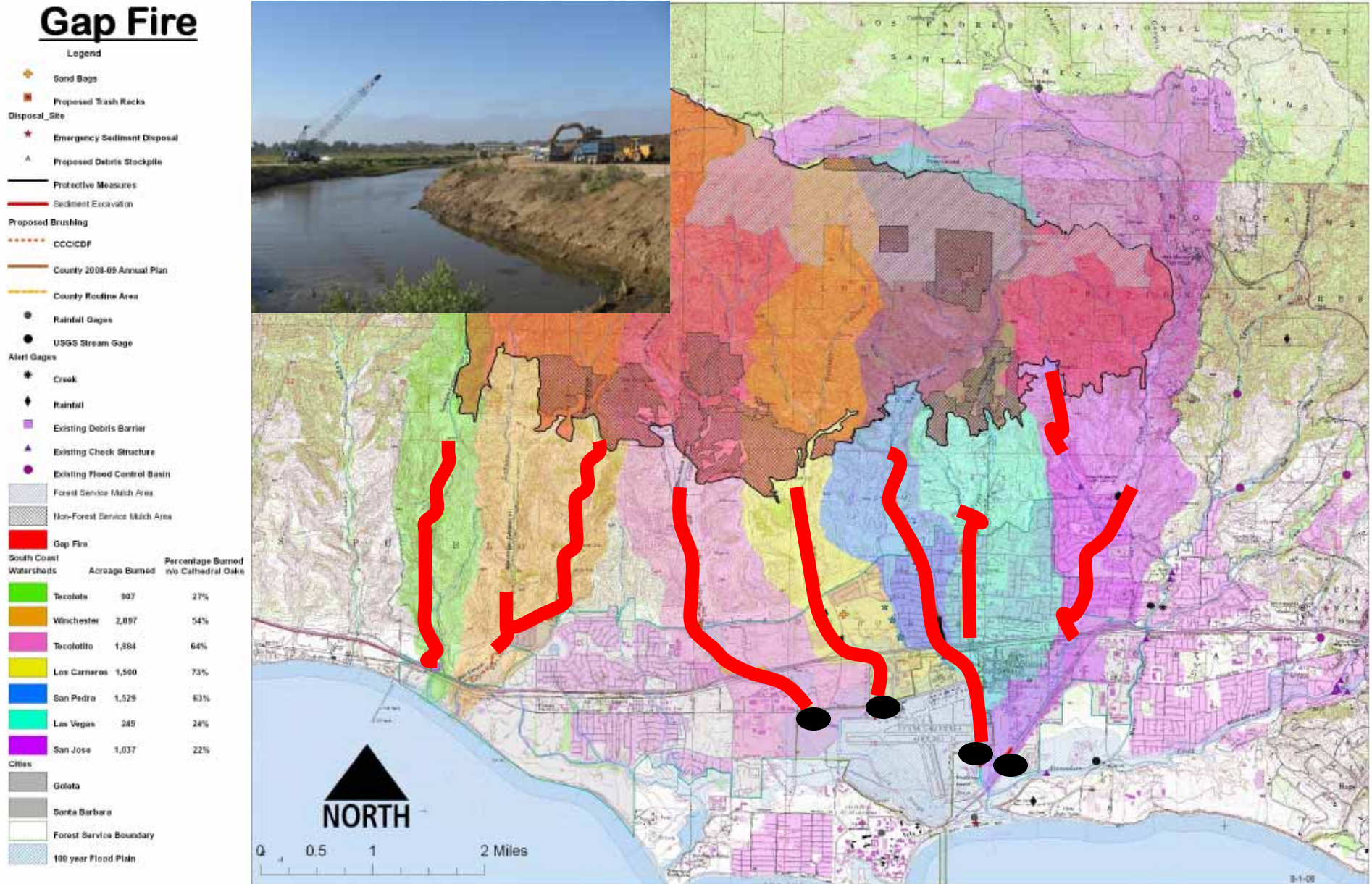
Stream Clearing - Completed



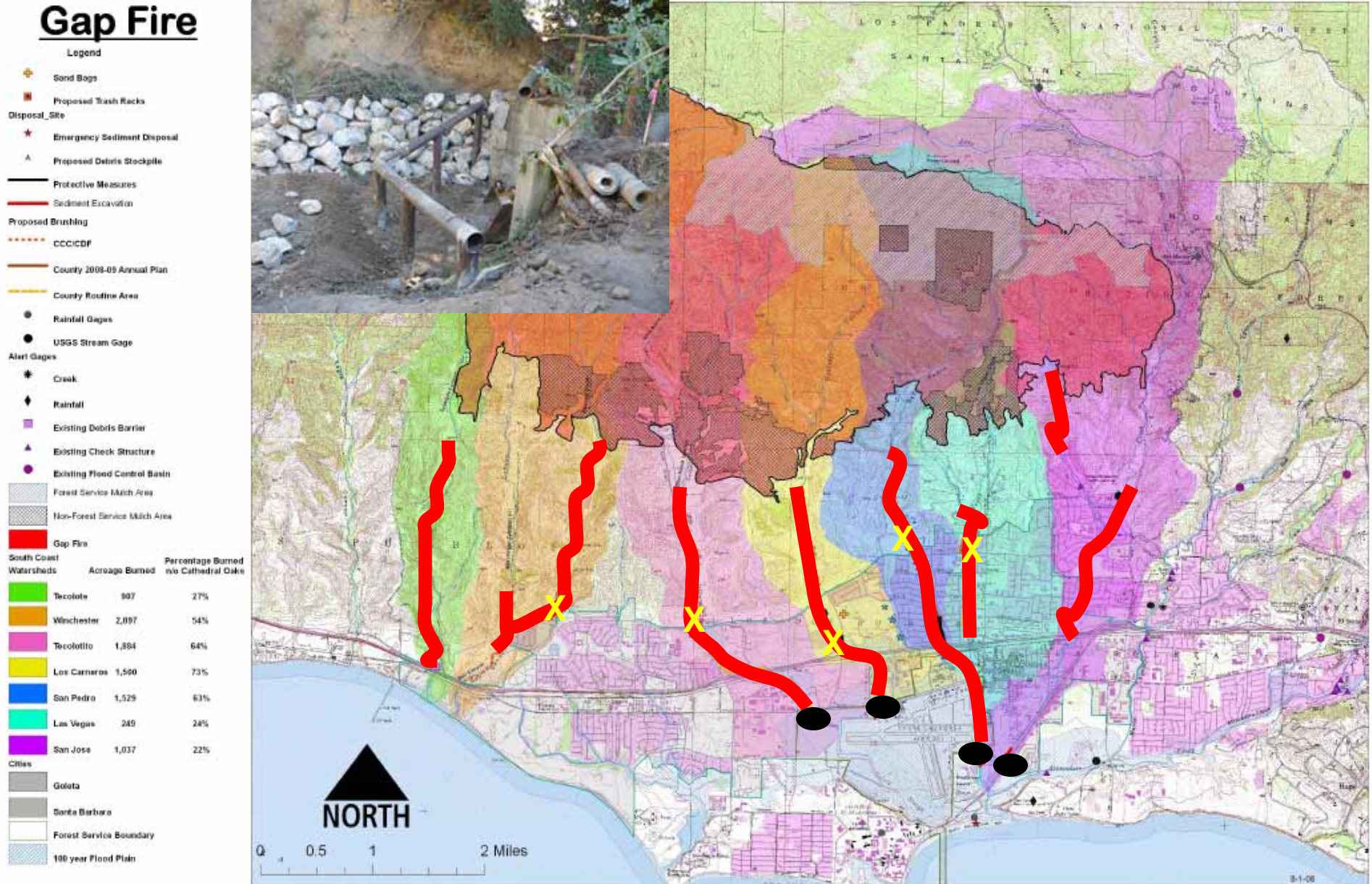
Sediment Basins - Identified



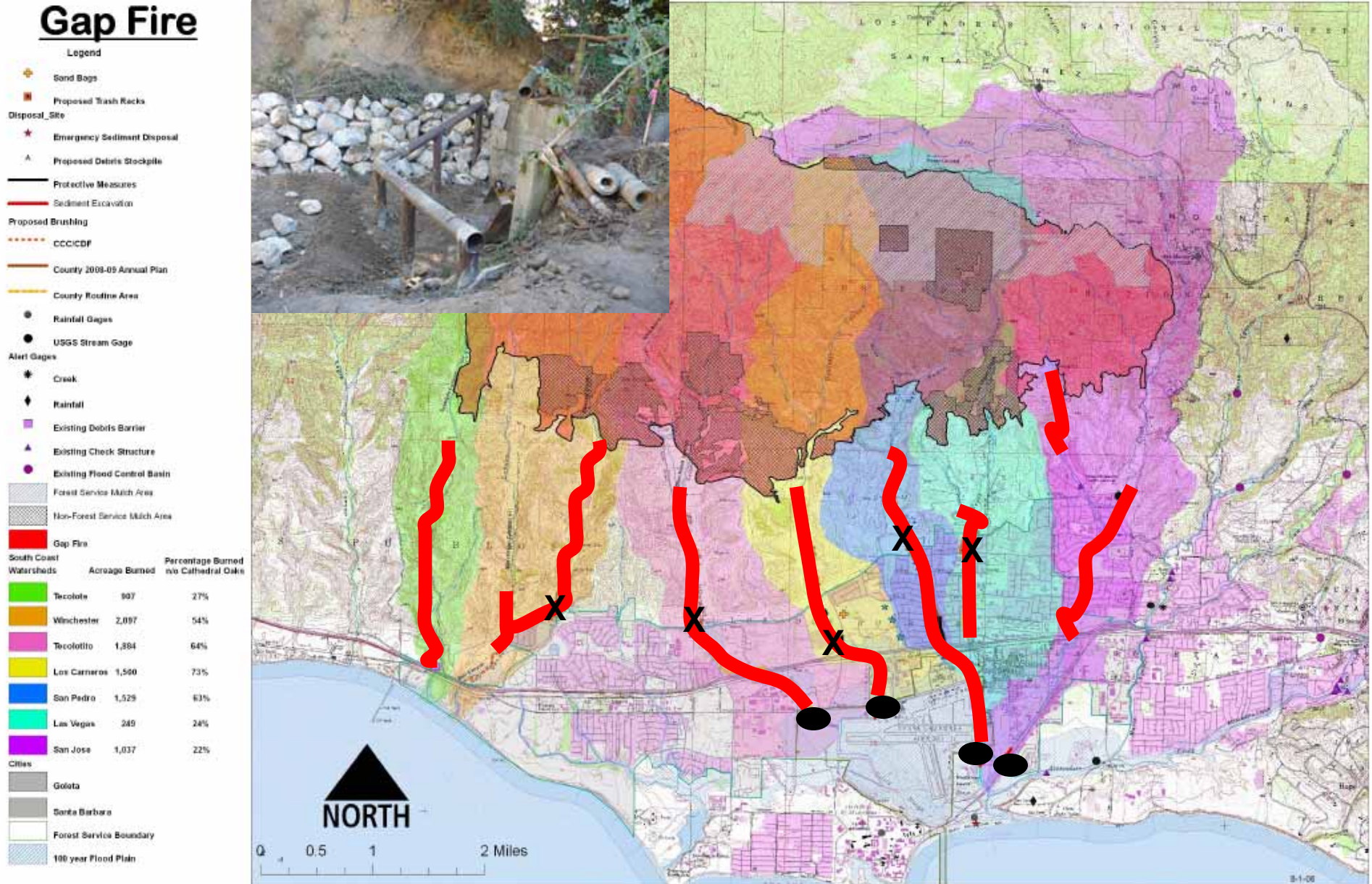

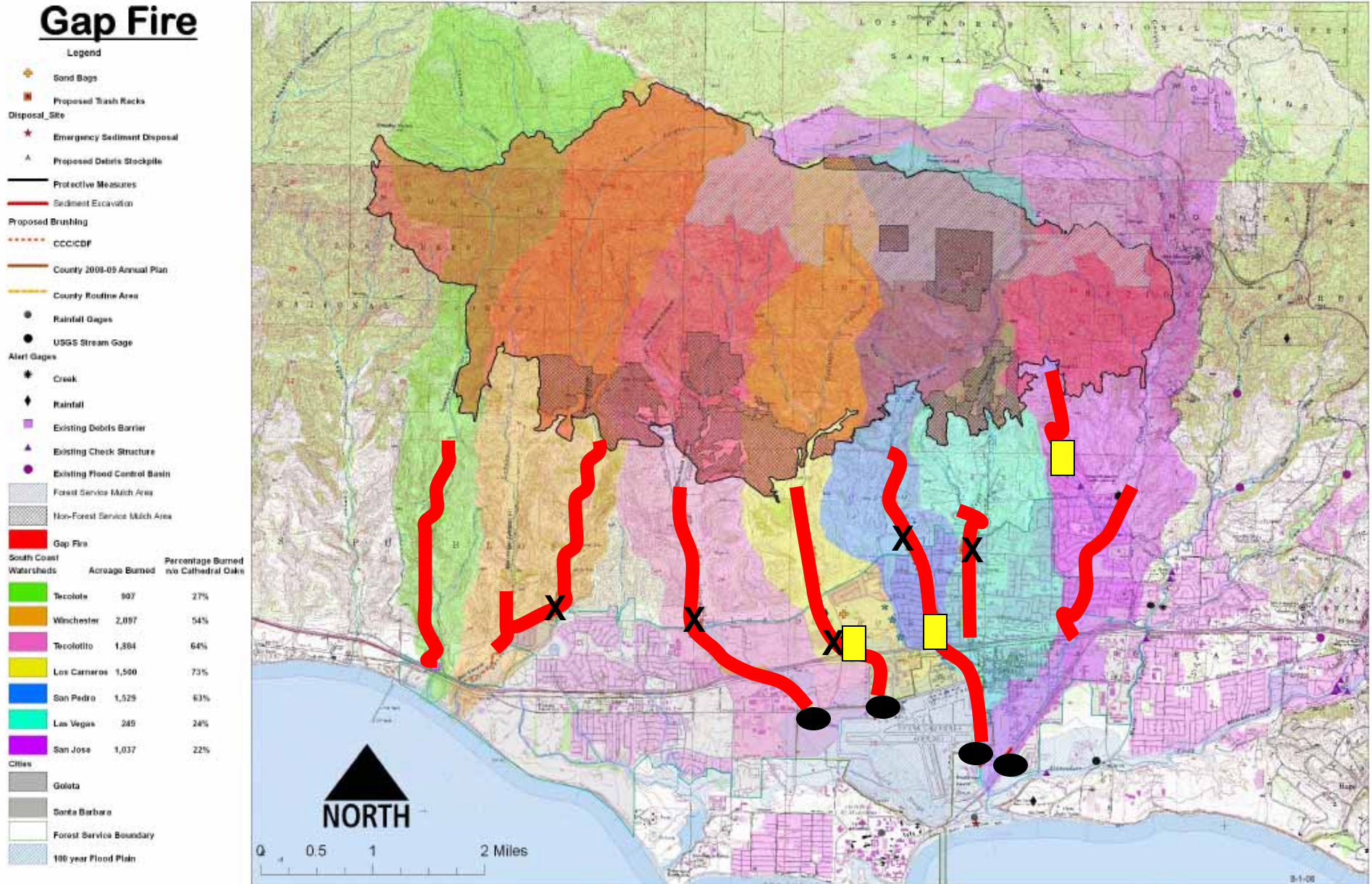
Debris Racks - Identified



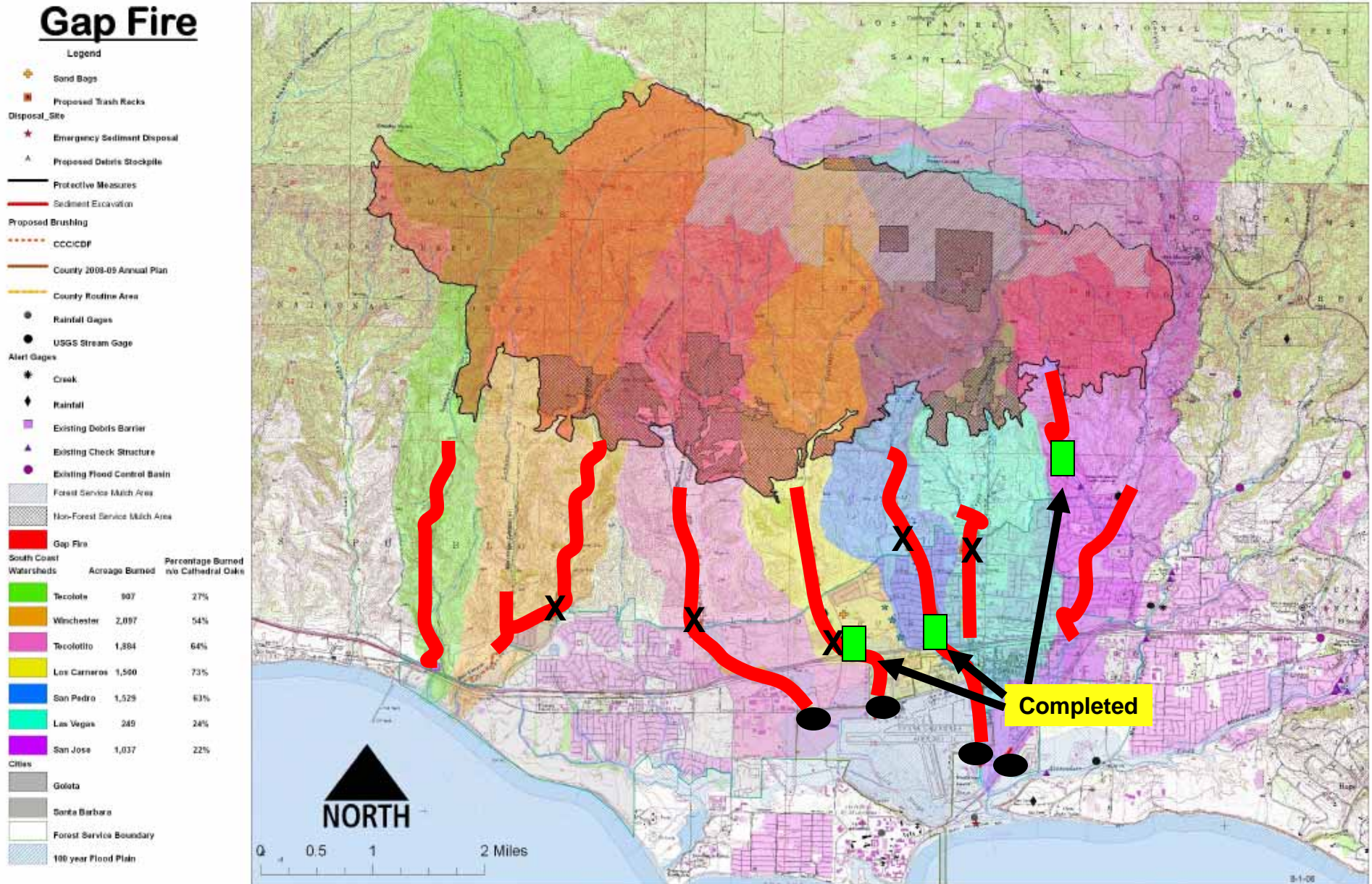

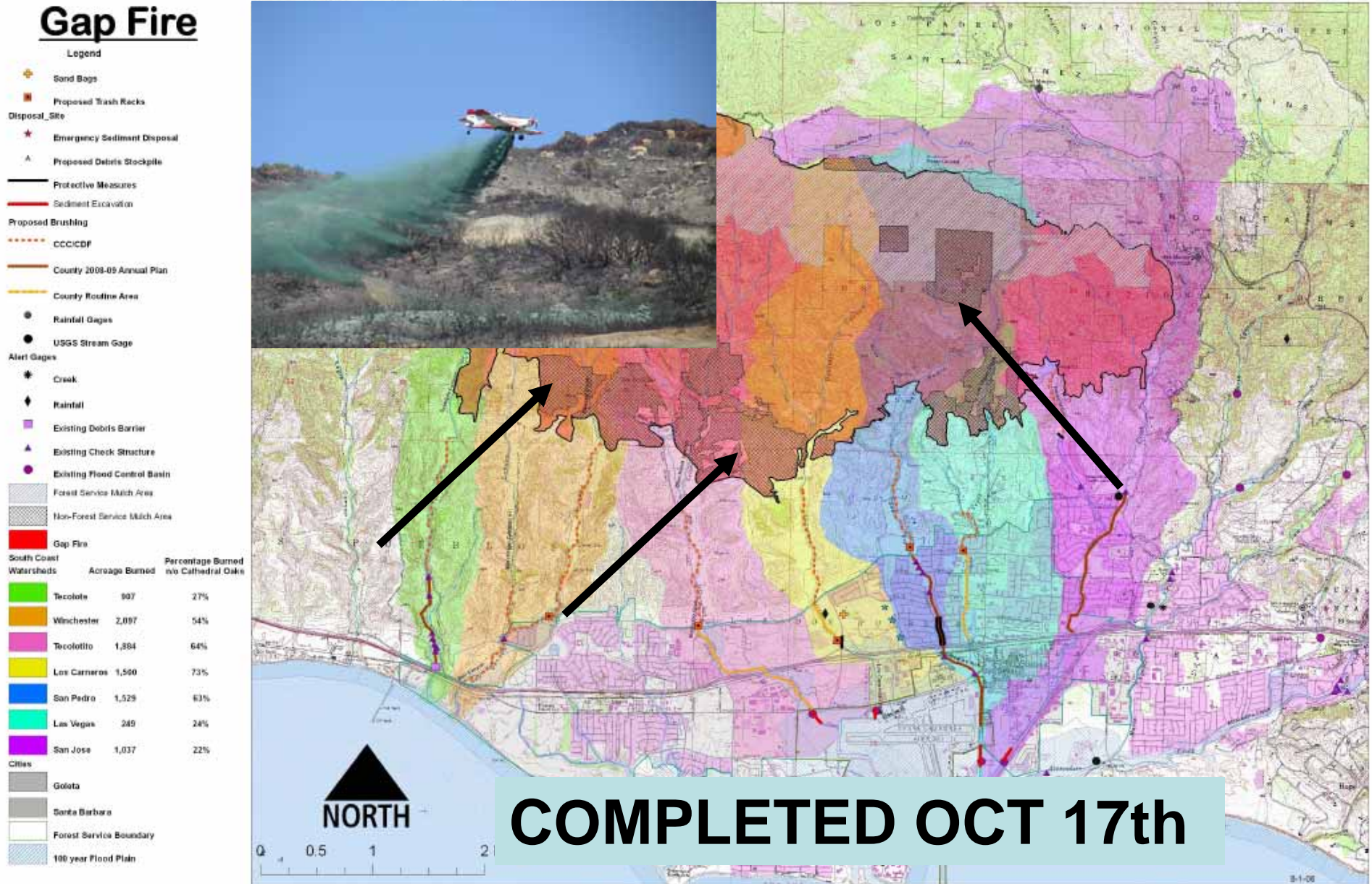

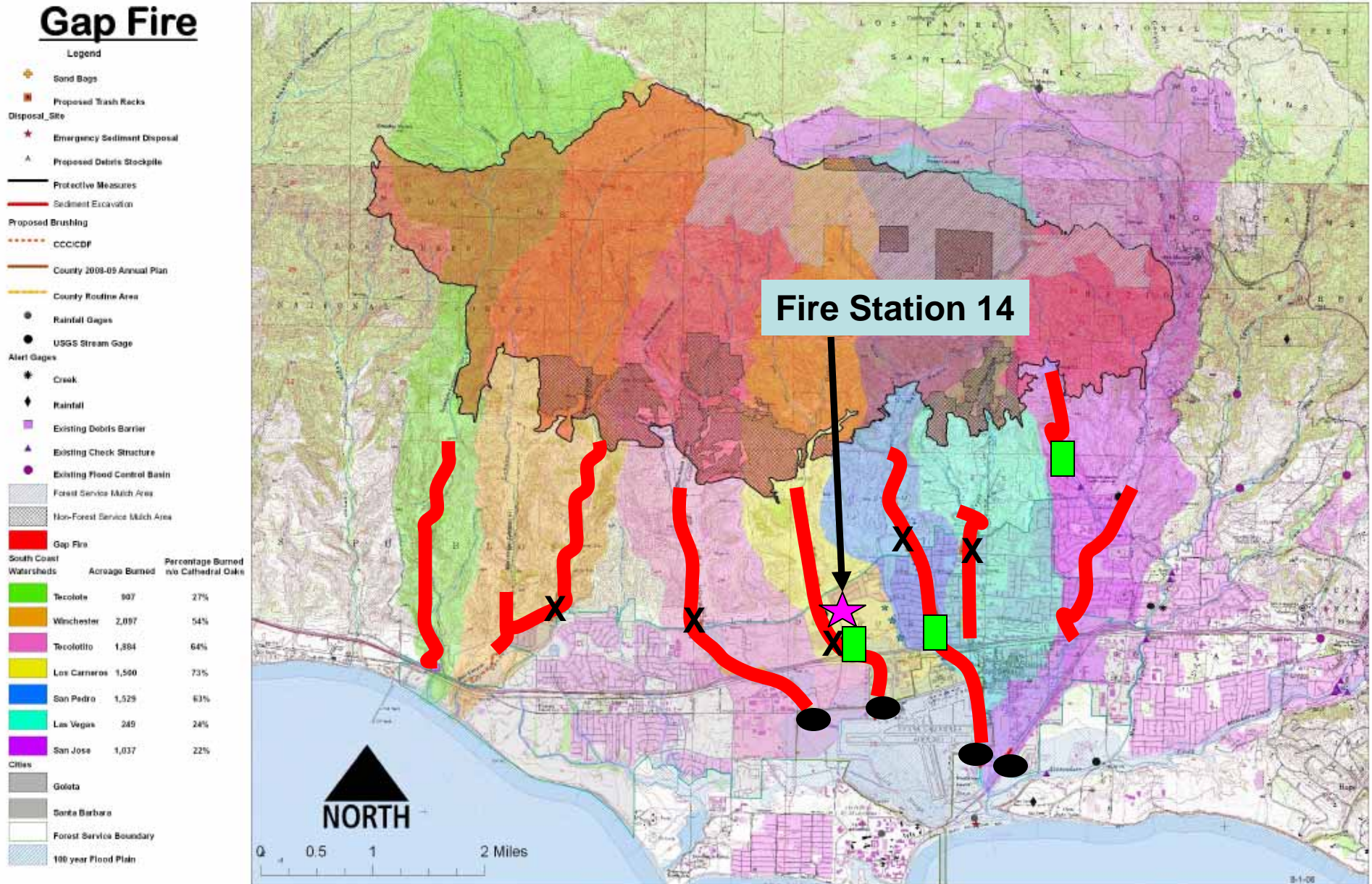

Watershed Project Costs



- Total Project Costs Estimated at up to \$4.7 Million
- County Secured Federal Funding (NRCS) for 75% of project costs up to \$3.76 Million
- Remaining 25% may receive further State Cost Sharing
- Aerial Hydromulch Project local costs to be shared with the Cities of Goleta and Santa Barbara
