WHEREAS, the Code of Santa Barbara County, California, Section 23-11, authorizes the Board of Supervisors of the County by Resolution, to designate portions of roads and highways under its jurisdiction as loading zones; and

WHEREAS, it appears to be in the best interest of public safety that certain portions of County highways in Santa Barbara County be designated as loading zones, in accordance with said Section; and

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED, that the following locations in Santa Barbara County and under the jurisdiction of the Board of Supervisors of said County is hereby designated as a passenger loading zone 7 a.m. to 3 p.m. school days only:

On the west side of Bethany Street from a point 205 feet north of the centerline of Clark Avenue to a point 275 feet north of the centerline of Clark Avenue.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Santa Barbara County Director of Public Works or designee is hereby authorized and directed to designate said locations with appropriate markings and/or signs as time and resources permit.
