FIRST AMENDMENT

TO

SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA as ADMINISTRATIVE ENTITY FOR THE SANTA MARIA/SANTA BARBARA COUNTY CONTINUUM OF CARE AND

NBCC, A California Public Benefit Nonprofit Corporation

State of California Emergency Solutions and Housing (CESH) Program

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT ("First Amendment") is made by and between

COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA, a political subdivision of the State of California, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY",

and

NBCC

a California Public Benefit Nonprofit Corporation, hereinafter referred to as "SUBRECIPIENT;"

With reference to the following:

WHEREAS, the State of California Emergency Solutions and Housing (CESH) Program ("Program") is authorized under State SB 850 (Stats. 2018, Ch. 48 §4) and operates under the requirements of the California Health and Safety Code, Chapter 2.8 of Part 2 of Division 31, commencing with section 50490 and including sections 50490.1, 50490.2, 50490.3, 50490.4 and 50490.5; and

WHEREAS, SUBRECIPIENT represents that it is specially trained, skilled, experienced and competent to provide the housing and services required by the COUNTY; and

WHEREAS, COUNTY and SUBRECIPIENT entered into a Subrecipient Agreement effective March 1, 2020, for Expansion of the Safe Parking Program Click here to enter text. partially funded by the Homeless Emergency Aid Program (HEAP) and State of California Emergency Solutions and Housing (CESH) Program (hereinafter "Agreement") in the amount of \$483,400; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement sets forth SUBRECIPIENT's obligations regarding the provision of services and staffing as delineated in Section I, "Scope of Service" and sets forth the expenses, staff salaries, and staff benefits eligible for reimbursement in Exhibit B of the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, COUNTY has unexpended CESH funds remaining in the amount of \$41,834 and available General Fund interest in the amount of \$18,227; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend the AGREEMENT, Section IV. Payment, and EXHIBIT B, Budget and Payment Procedures, to increase funding in the amount of \$60,061.00; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend the name of the SUBRECIPIENT to substitute the current entity name as NBCC, a California Public Benefit Nonprofit Corporation, dba New Beginnings Counseling Center, instead of the previously referenced entity name of New Beginnings Counseling Center; and

WHEREAS, Section VI.E, "Changes or Amendments," of the Agreement provides that COUNTY and SUBRECIPIENT may amend the Agreement at any time provided that such amendments make specific reference to the Agreement, and are executed in writing, signed by a duly authorized representative of each party, and approved by COUNTY's governing body; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree to amend the Agreement, as follows:

- All references to SUBRECIPIENT as New Beginnings Counseling Center in the AGREEMENT shall be replaced by NBCC, a California Public Benefit Nonprofit Corporation, dba New Beginnings Counseling Center.
- 2. The first sentence of Section IV, PAYMENT, of the AGREEMENT, is hereby replaced in its entirety as follows in order to increase the total maximum amount of the AGREEMENT:

It is expressly agreed and understood that the total amount to be paid by COUNTY under this Agreement shall not exceed \$543,461.

3. Section VI.E, Changes or Amendments, subsection 1, of the AGREEMENT is hereby replaced in its entirety as follows:

Increase or decrease the total contract maximum amount by amending the Budget, attached hereto as Exhibit B, which includes Attachments B-1 and B-2, of the Agreement to ensure full and timely expenditure of all awarded CESH funds; provided that any increase to the Agreement shall not exceed 10% of the original total contract maximum amount of the Agreement; and further provided that all expenditures must be eligible pursuant to the California Health and Safety Code, Chapter 2.8 of Part 2 of Division 31, commencing with section 50490 and including sections 50490.1, 50490.2, 50490.3, 50490.4 and 50490.5, and all other applicable laws. In no event shall an amendment be made pursuant to this subsection VI.E.1 that will result in any change to the Scope of Services attached hereto as Exhibit A.

4. EXHIBIT B, Budget and Payment Procedures, ATTACHMENT 1 and ATTACHMENT 2, of the AGREEMENT are hereby replaced in their entirety by the following:
