**Recommended Actions:**

That the Board of Supervisors adopt a resolution effective June 15, 2009 establishing the classifications of:

Extra-Help Special I – ARRA, salary range 3502 (\$8.00 - \$9.766/hour)

Extra-Help Special II – ARRA, salary range 3996 (\$10.235 - \$12.494/hour)

**Summary Text:**

This action establishes temporary classifications for departments to use when hiring American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) eligible recipients into subsidized workforce training/extra-help positions.

**Background:**

The Federal stimulus funding, through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA), provides money for subsidized employment from the TANF contingency fund. The Department of Social Services proposes to use the funds to subsidize the employment of job-ready CalWorks recipients. The recipients would be employed by County departments as extra-help employees. The subsidy rate would be set depending on the type of work and qualifications of the recipient.

ARRA funding is expected to expire in two years. CEO/Human Resources will return to the Board to delete the temporary classifications when they are no longer needed.

**Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:**

There is no fiscal impact associated with establishing the classification. The cost of ARRA participants will be funded by ARRA.
