RESOLUTION HONORING VENTURA COUNTY FIREFIGHTERS BRIAN BULGER, ROBERT LOPEZ AND RON TOPOLINSKI FOR EXTRAORDINARY SERVICE IN RESPONDING TO THE JESUSITA FIRE

## CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, on May 5, 2009 at approximately 1:45 P.M. a fire started in the Cathedral Peak area of Santa Barbara County and became known as the Jesusita Fire; and,

WHEREAS, Ventura County Fire Department was one of the first regional responders on the scene due to the State's mutual aid system and an essential part of the personnel on scene; and,

WHEREAS, while defending the homes of County residents in the Mission Canyon area from the approaching fire, on May 6, 2009, the wind quickly changed direction, flames overcame the engine and forced Captain Ron Topolinski and Firefighter Robert Lopez to seek shelter in a home they were protecting; and,

WHEREAS, driven by winds at speeds of nearly 60 miles per hour, the house caught fire forcing Topolinski and Lopez to flee; however, Captain Brain Bulger was able to pull the two firefighters into his vehicle; and,

WHEREAS, all three firefighters exhibited exemplary signs of bravery and heroism, dedication to upholding the Ventura County Fire Department's vision "to deliver the highest level of public service through a team effort" and commitment to protecting the properties and lives of Santa Barbara County residents.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors recognizes and expresses its heartfelt admiration and thanks to Captain Brain Bulger, Firefighter Robert Lopez and Captain Ron Topolinski for their extraordinary service to the County of Santa Barbara in responding to the Jesusita Fire
