Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors:

- a) Approve, ratify and authorize the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute the professional services agreement with Bengal Engineering, Inc. (Bengal) in the amount not to exceed \$72,287 to allow Bengal to provide engineering services for the Goleta Beach Pier structural inspection (Attachment A); and
- b) Determine that the above recommended action does not constitute a project subject to environmental review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15309 which consists of activities limited entirely to inspections, to check for performance of an operation, or quality, health, or safety of a project or product.

Summary Text:

The attached professional service agreement will allow Bengal Engineering, Inc. (Bengal) to provide engineering services for above- and below-water structural inspections of the Goleta Beach Pier as a result of the January 2023 storm event. When combined with other existing County contracts, the Bengal contract of \$72,287 will exceed \$200,000 in County-wide contracts with Bengal.

Background:

The 1,500-foot Goleta Beach Pier is located within Goleta Beach Park. The fishing and pedestrian pier is primarily a timber structure with an actively utilized boat hoist and was originally constructed in 1954

with an extension constructed in 1980. During the January 2023 storm event, the pier might have sustained damage and has been closed to the public until an engineered safety inspection can be completed. Board approval of the recommended actions will allow Bengal to provide the structural inspections in order to identify any necessary repairs.

Risk:

The agreement applies County standard independent contractor terms and conditions in accordance with State of California laws and regulations, and federal laws and regulations, where applicable. The risk mitigation includes insurance coverage appropriate for the level of risk involved as determined by Community Services in conjunction with the County Risk Manager, and the agreement indemnifies County agents, officers, and employees from all claims that arise from activities performed under the agreement.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

All costs for work conducted by the Contractor are budgeted within the Community Services Department Parks Division operational budget.
