- a) Adopt the attached Rules of Procedure for the Agricultural Advisory Committee
- b) Adopt new eligibility requirements for Agricultural Advisory Committee members

Summary Text:

The proposed Rules of Procedure and eligibility requirements are included as Attachment A.

Background:

On March 14, 1995, the Board of Supervisors approved the formation of the Agricultural Advisory Committee, the membership and the eligibility requirements. The Board did not adopt Rules of Procedure and meeting guidelines at that time. As questions were raised as to conduct of meetings and procedures for interacting with your Board and other agencies the need for guidelines became apparent. The Committee worked with County Counsel to develop the attached guidelines.

The Board approved eligibility requirement for Committee membership is that "all nominees shall realize at least 50% of their income from agriculture." This has proven problematic for several reasons: 1. There is no way to verify income sources; 2. For farmers and ranchers, particularly those that are

retired or approaching retirement, income varies from year to year and other income may reduce agricultural income below the 50% threshold, and 3. Board member and some commodity groups are having trouble finding eligible people willing to serve on the Committee or as an alternate. The Committee recommends changing the eligibility to "all nominees shall have knowledge of or background in agriculture."

At your Board meeting on February 5, 2008, the item was continued to add term limits. Four year term limits in one additional term without a break in service has been added.
