SUBJECT: Sublease Agreement; 109 East Victoria Street, Santa Barbara

Real Property file # R-133 First Supervisorial District

Recommendation(s):

That the Board of Supervisors Approve and execute the Sublease Agreement with Penfield and Smith as Sublessee for 3,200 square feet of office space located at 109 East Victoria Street, for the period of July 1, 2004 through March 31, 2006 in the amount of \$6,703.17 per month, plus taxes and maintenance costs during its occupancy of the building, Santa Barbara, First District.

Alignment with Board Strategic Plan:

The recommendation(s) are primarily aligned with actions required by law or by routine business necessity.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

The Board of Supervisors executed the original Lease Agreement (herein the "Master Lease") on June 4, 2002 (Clerk of the Board file #02-00588). The Master Lease allowed the County's Public Works Department, Solid Waste Division to occupy the office building at 109 East Victoria Street in the City of Santa Barbara.

The office building is approximately 3,200 square feet. The current monthly rent is \$6,703.17 per month plus taxes, utilities and internal janitorial services. The original base term of the Master Lease was two years commencing April 1, 2002 and terminating March 31, 2004. The County has three options to extend the term of the Master Lease, each option is for a period of

two years. The Director of Public Works exercised the first option extending the term of the Master Lease thru March 31, 2006.

Solid Waste is scheduled to move into the new County building currently under construction at 130 East Victoria Street on July 1, 2004. By executing the option to extend the Master Lease, Solid Waste retains the right to occupy 109 East Victoria until the new building is ready for occupancy. The Sublessee will occupy 109 East Victoria when Solid Waste moves out until the end of the current lease term while their headquarters is being remodeled.

In March of 2006 the County will have the option of extending the lease term to March 31, 2008 if it is determined the County is in need of the additional office space. If the County does not exercise its option in 2006, all County rights and responsibilities for 109 E. Victoria are terminated.

Mandates and Service Levels:

No change in programs or service levels.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

The monthly rent, utilities and taxes will be paid by the Sublessee (Penfield & Smith) after commencement of the Sublease. This action will decrease the Facilities square footage for which the County is responsible.
