RESOLUTION OF RECOGNITION
NATIONAL CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS WEEK

WHEREAS, the week of May 3rd through May 9th represents a period of time where Correctional Officers across the United States are recognized for their service and dedication to their local communities; and

WHEREAS, Custody Operations of the Santa Barbara County Sheriff's Office – consisting of the Main Jail, Medium Security and Santa Maria Branch Jail facilities, Auxiliary Services, Classification, and the Transportation Unit – are highly regarded professionals working in concert with other local criminal justice and public safety entities; and

WHEREAS, forty-two years ago the Sheriff's Office and this Board recognized the need to create a Sheriff's Correction Officer rank structure, since changed to Custody Deputy, that would best serve the duties of a custody deputy specifically trained in the unique needs of a detention facility responsible for the housing, security and transportation of all inmates incarcerated in Santa Barbara County; and

WHEREAS, Custody Deputies, reporting for duty ready for the challenges of an ever more complex county jail system, are faced with danger in their work environment on a 24/7 basis, all the while maintaining order, security and preserving the care, custody and dignity of those individuals charged to their care; and

WHEREAS, the citizen of Santa Barbara can rest assured that these men and women are dedicated to their service and perform their duties in a professional and ethical manner while displaying integrity, courage and fairness, thus ensuring safety of the community, their fellow officers, and incarcerated individuals.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors recognizes the week of May 3-9, 2015, as "National Correctional Officers' Week" and takes this opportunity to thank the men and women of the Sheriff's Office who have chosen the field of Corrections as their service to our community.
