**RE: Local Primacy Delegation Agreement Amendments**

Dear Mr. Polhemus:

This is a follow up to my letter to you dated January 17, 2017 regarding amendments to the Local Primacy Agreement that was entered into between the California Department of Health (CDPH) and Santa Barbara County effective December 9, 2013. The amendments are set forth in your letter of January 9, 2017.

In an action taken on March 21, 2017, the Santa Barbara County Board of Supervisors voted to approve the amendments and authorized the Public Health Director to notify the State Water Quality Control Board (SWQCB) of the County acceptance. Santa Barbara County hereby accepts the terms and conditions of the Amendments pursuant to your letter of January 9, 2017 and agrees to implement said Amendments beginning on the effective date April 1, 2017.

In addition to the amendments offered by the SWQCB the County recommends further amendments that specifically recognize the SWQCB in place of CDPH as the administering agency for the program.
