Recommendation(s):

That the Board of Supervisors continue the hearing scheduled for July 26, 2005 to September 13, 2005.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

On June 21, 2005 the Board set a hearing to: a) Consider the introduction of an ordinance amending sections of Chapter 2, Article V relating to the creation of regional County Boards of Architectural Review, and b) Find that this is not an activity subject to CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines sections 15060 (c) (3) and 15378. A Subcommittee of the Board of Supervisors and staff have been working to solicit public input and to develop proposed documents for the Board of Supervisors to consider.

These processes are detailed and require additional time. Therefore staff recommends continuance of the hearing from July 26, 2005 to the next available meeting. The next available meeting is September 13, 2005 in Santa Maria.
