RECOMMENDATIONS

That the Board of Supervisors adopt a resolution establishing an Accessible Parking Zone on Grand Avenue in the Los Olivos area.

ALIGNMENT WITH BOARD STRATEGIC PLAN

The recommendation is primarily aligned with Goal #2: Ensure the public health and safety and provide essential infrastructure and Goal #5: Maintain and enhance the quality of life for all residents.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY & DISCUSSION

Grand Avenue runs between S.R. 154 and Alamo Pintado Road and is one of the main collector roads running north/south through downtown Los Olivos. The road consists of two travel lanes with on-street angle parking and businesses fronting both sides of the street. A request was made for the installation of an accessible parking zone on Grand Avenue near the intersection of Hollister Street. Based on a field investigation, it was determined by the Traffic Section staff that an accessible parking zone could be established at the following location:

On the east side of Grand Avenue from a point 175 feet north of the centerline of Hollister Street to a point 117 feet south of Alamo Pintado Avenue.

In accordance with the American Disabilities Act (ADA), the accessible parking zone will consist of a parking stall (min. 9' 0" wide) and a loading and unloading zone (min. 5' 0" wide) located on the passenger side of the vehicle for persons with disabilities.
