That the Board of Supervisors:

- a) Adopt the attached Resolution accepting a new section on Refugio Road into the County Maintained Road System;
- b) Adopt the attached Resolution certifying the total mileage included in the County Maintained Road System; and
- c) Find that the proposed actions do not constitute a "Project" within the meaning of the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to 14 CCR 15378 (b)(5) (Organizational or administrative activities of governments that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment).

Summary Text:

This item is on the agenda to update the list of roadway sections in the Santa Barbara County Maintained Road System. The addition of a new section on Refugio Road will result in a newly calculated total mileage of 827.93 for the County Maintained Road System. Upon your Board's approval and certification, Public Works will report this mileage to the State of California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) for the purposes of determining the County's share of state road maintenance funds.

Background:

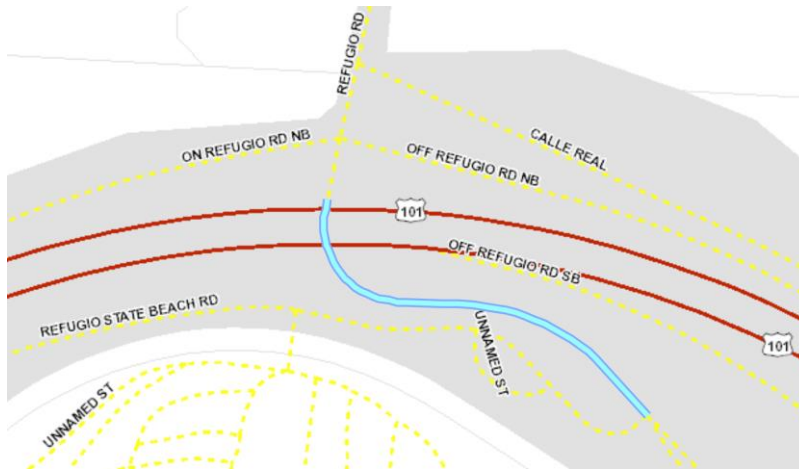


Figure 1. Limits of the new section on Refugio Road

Attachment A contains one new roadway section on Refugio Road located in the Third Supervisorial District. This 0.31-mile section connects the southern end of Refugio Road to the Highway 101 on/off-ramp on the south/east side of the Highway 101 overpass. This section on Refugio Road is illustrated in Figure 1. During conversation with Caltrans and research for their upcoming overpass replacement project, it was determined that the County had agreed to maintain this section of road in a Freeway

Maintenance Agreement dated 6/26/1967. As a result it is being added to the County Maintained Road System.

County Maintained Mileage Certification

Attachment B requests your Board to take action intended to satisfy Streets and Highways Code § 2121. Streets and Highways Code § 2121 requires the County to report annually to Caltrans any additions or exclusions from the total mileage of the County Maintained Road System for the purpose of maintenance funding allocation. Attachment B also includes the measurement updates and corrections made in the past fiscal year. The above changes result in a new total maintained roadway mileage. Caltrans requires that the adjusted maintained roadway mileage total be certified by your Board and reported to them for the purposes of road maintenance funding allocations, partially based on the total number of roadway miles maintained by the County.
