RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING APRIL FRIDAY NIGHT LIVE MONTH IN SANTA BARBARA COUNTY

WHEREAS, Santa Barbara County residents recognize the importance of health and safety, but suffer from alcohol, tobacco, and other drug abuse issues in the community; and

WHEREAS, the month of April is known for recognizing Alcohol Awareness, Cannabis Awareness and the California Friday Night Live partnership, a positive youth development program dedicated to fostering leadership in young people so they can advocate against drugs & alcohol; and

WHEREAS, the Council on Alcohol and Drug Abuse (CADA) oversees Santa Barbara County Friday Night Live (FNL) program locally to allow youth the opportunity to plan prevention campaigns for their peers in order to promote a drug-free lifestyle locally; and

WHEREAS, the mission of CADA to build a safer, healthier community by preventing and treating alcoholism and drug abuse. CADA supports families, youth and adults through our prevention, education, intervention and public awareness programs in addition to providing treatment and referrals; and

WHEREAS, the goal of the CADA, the FNL program, encourage families, schools, businesses, media, government, medical institutions, faith-based organizations, law enforcement agencies, and other youth to foster an atmosphere that supports a healthy lifestyle for youth, and educates and creates awareness of the harms of substance abuse; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors proclaims the Month of April, 2021 as Friday Night Live Month in Santa Barbara County and encourages all residents to support and participate in alcohol and other drug prevention activities.
