SUBJECT: Construction of Arroyo Burro Beach County Park Trash Enclosure Improvements,
Project No. D40025; Second Supervisorial District

Recommendation(s):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- A. Approve plans and specifications for the project;
- B. Award the construction contract in the amount of \$ 106,130.00 to the lowest responsible bidder, R. Burke Corporation, P.O. Box 957, San Luis Obispo, CA 93406 subject to the provision of documents and certifications, as set forth in the plans and specifications applicable to the project and as required by law;
- C. Approve and authorize Chair to execute the construction contract upon return of the contractor's executed contract documents, and the review and approval of the County Counsel, Auditor-Controller and Risk Manager or their authorized representatives.

Alignment with Board Strategic Plan:

The recommendation(s) are primarily aligned with Goal No. 5.A High Quality of Life for All Residents.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

The project includes the demolition, removal and reconstruction of the existing trash staging area (adjacent to Brown Pelican Restaurant) and the main solid waste / dumpster storage area adjacent to Cliff Drive. The solid waste holding areas will be fully enclosed to exclude rodents and birds and will include a roof to minimize storm runoff into and from the enclosure areas. The concrete flooring of the enclosure areas will be re-constructed to drain into a catch basin area that will contain and filter the water. A connection from the

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catch basin areas to the sanitary sewer system, which includes a grease trap, will be installed to eliminate the runoff from entering nearby Arroyo Burro Creek.

On February 17, 2005, 8 project bids were received. R. Burke Corporation of San Luis Obispo was the low bidder for the project. Parks staff has performed an analysis of the bid and has determined that the low bid is reasonable and recommends the award of this contract.

This project is located within the City of Santa Barbara local coastal plan jurisdiction. A permit exclusion was approved by the City on June 22, 2004.

Mandates and Service Levels: No mandates or impact to service levels with this action.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts: Funding for this project is through a \$227,000 grant from the Clean Beach Initiative Program under Proposition 13, administered by the State Water Resources Control Board and is located in the Parks ACO budget 1931.
