#### **Recommended Actions:**

That the Board of Supervisors:

Consider Case No. 07AGP-00000-00008, for nonrenewal by the County of an existing agricultural preserve contract.

- A. Accept the request for nonrenewal of Agricultural Preserve 73-AP-010, and;
- B. Execute the attached Notice of Nonrenewal by the County Land Conservation Contract for Assessor's Parcel No. 129-170-002, located on Dominion Road, approximately ½ mile west of the intersection of Clark Avenue and Dominion Road, Santa Maria Area, Fifth Supervisorial District.

### **Summary Text:**

The subject property has been in an agricultural preserve (73-AP-010) since January 1, 1974. On May 4, 2007 the Agricultural Preserve Advisory Committee voted not to renew an Agricultural Preserve Contract (73-AP-010) due to the absence of agricultural activities on site, and the inability to meet size

requirements required for a replacement contract. Nonrenewal of the contract will become effective December 31, 2007. The site size is 79.09 acres.

# **Background:**

Government Code §51200 (known as the California Land Conservation Act of 1965 or the Williamson Act) provides that local jurisdictions may establish an agricultural preserve program having the goal of retaining land in an agricultural use. The County of Santa Barbara has adopted such a program which is codified under the Agricultural Preserve Program Uniform Rules. Both the County's Uniform Rules and the Government Code provide that agricultural preserve contracts between the County and landowners are voluntary. Therefore, there are no state mandates associated with this program.
