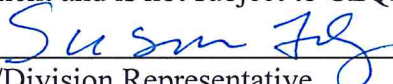
Project Description: Award of Human Services Commission grant funds to grantees for the use of County General Funds for FY 2014-15 for the delivery of Human Services Program services.
